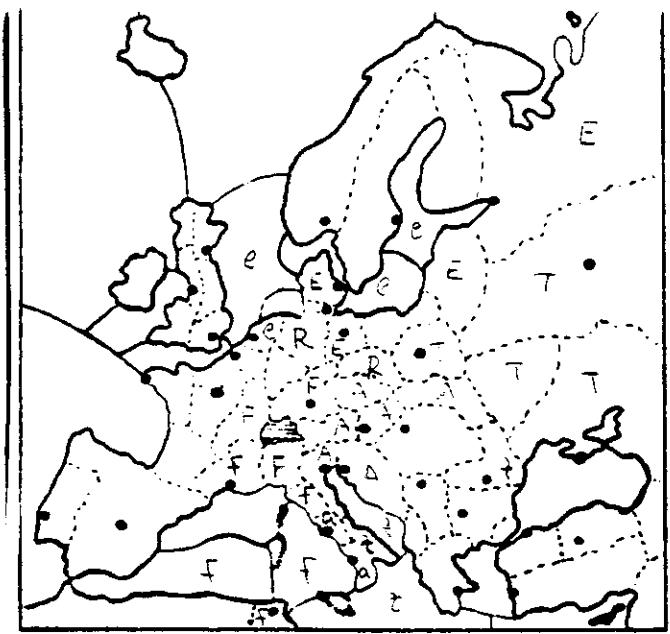

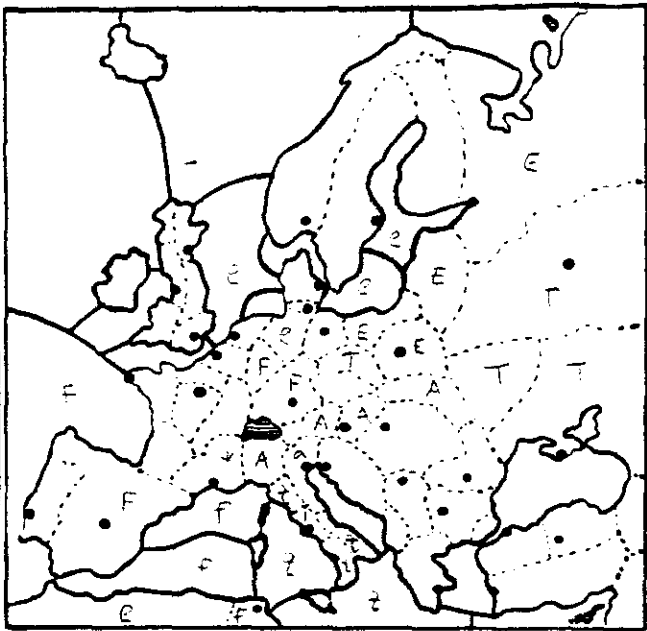

FRA)AUS: Are you the LIB's resident masochist?

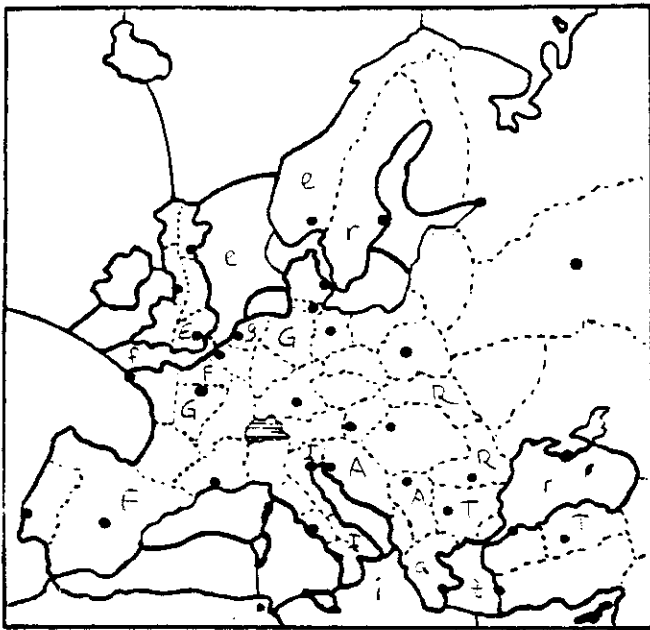
Suisse)World: We're obviously not going anywhere, so let's

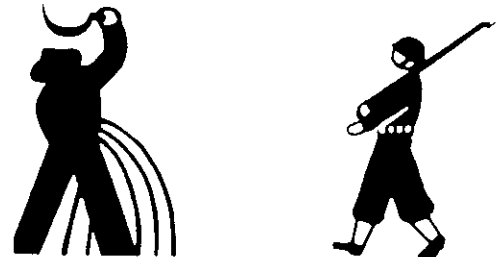

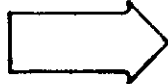

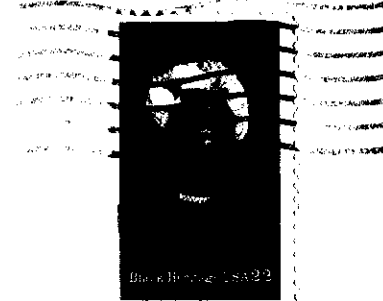
