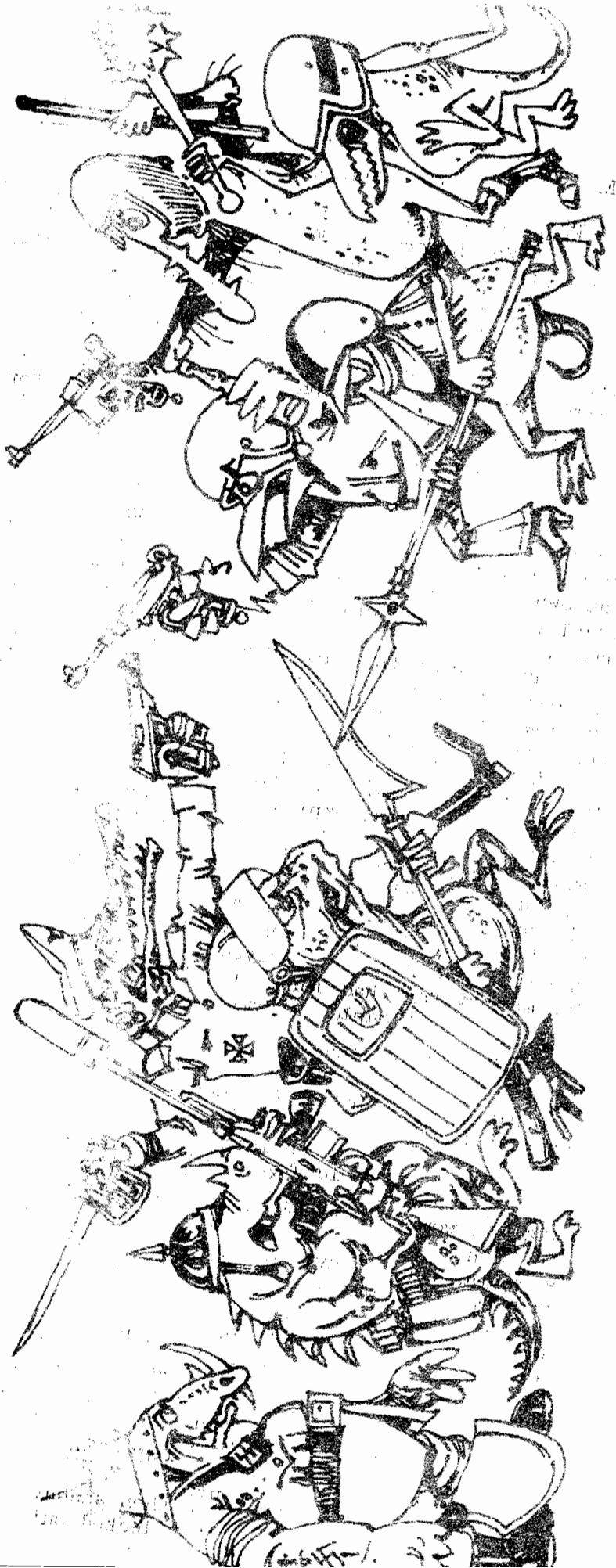

1940 AB

With this issue, I am enclosing 4 blank hex-grids of 13"x15.5" dimensions, together with a reduced-xerox copy of the terrain to be drawn upon these grids. The grids will be used for geomorphic maps for the 1940 AB scenario [and possibly other scenarios]. These maps have 12 configurations described on the xeroxed copy for use in different scenarios. There are configurations which are more open and will be used in some of the desert scenario possibilities. But none of these are entirely featureless. The terrain will still represent ridges, escarpments, boulders, etc.

Since these are maps with full-size hexes and there are 4 of them for each player, I am not drawing the terrain on them as I did for AB6. You must fill in your own hex-grids from the xerox model. I've trimmed the grids to the exact size needed, though.

These are being sent to all active AB6 players, and also to those who are to play the 1940 scenarios, free of charge. If anyone else wants full-size hex grids (13"x15.5" dimensions), the cost is 10¢ per sheet plus postage. 25¢ will get you a reduced xerox copy of the 1940 AB map.

I also still have 11x17" conference map reductions of a full-sized hex-grid (22x34") for 10¢ each.

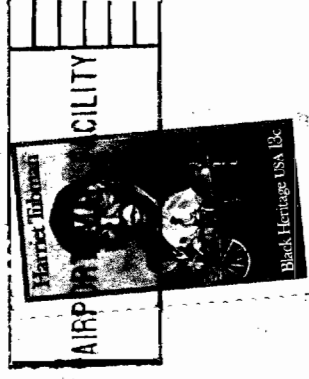
