PRESS RELEASES Game # 1

Vladivostok, Russia March 17, 1900

Turkey firmly backs her European neighbors Italy, Germany, and Great Britain in theri reghteous desire to fry the Frenchies!"

Relations between these two nations have been near hostile since Turkey closed its Empassy in Paris in 1898, drove the hordes of French street-walkers out of Asia Minor, and banned the sale of certain French made items most noted for the feather attached to their ends. Note: Error in first rule sheet: Spring raids DO NOT establish control of a supply center for the purpose of supplies. Ex. A Mar Spa, A Spa Port. Only Port is established and will remain in French hands until taken in a similiar manner. E.g. F Mid A to Port on spring turn F Port to Spa (s.c.) does not establish Port as a base for the invading power, it would still be French.

Retreats should be specified if such a possibility exists. Otherwise the judge will retreat units back to the provence from which they left or back toward th home contry. If neither of these are possible he will choose where they are to go.
