Sept. 22, 1905, Rome, Italy

The government today said that the invasion of troops and fleets from other governments is just what this country needs to be put back on its feet. (After this statement the man was taken out and shot.)

Munich, Germany, August 12, 1905 (GASP)

The streets of Munich were the scene of the worst rioting in the history of Germany. At a recent rally the extremist group in the LSD movement led by Guru George Files known as the FEDERATION PARTY had a show of strength by having all their members disrobe in front of the Imperial Chancellery. Party spokesman Dill Prithurd (a distant relation of the more famous Pill) said "We wish to provide Germany with an alternative to some of the previous leadership policies which have been directing our country." "Yoa, dat's wite," added Phoney Moraley (an ex-Italian Ambassador with contacts in the underworld all over Europe) "we's gonna rub dem pigs out!"

The pigs he referred to were the members of the Val Can Kling On To-Party headed by Johann Boobekoner (head of the German State Department) and Leonardo Lakofinski (commander of the 6th German army). As yet it has not been discovered exactly what Val Can cling on to, but. . . .

Violence which started here has spread all over Germany.  
Berlin, Germany September 22, 1905 (GASP)

In a press conference here today the Kaiser pleaded for reconciliation between the groups which have been battling in the streets for over six weeks. "This turmoil is a constant source of concern for me, but I will not use armed force to destroy either of those groups. I know their intentions are good, even if their frustrations have led them to violence," said the Emperor.

Puck, Prussia, October 20, 1905 (GASP)

Field Marshal Gerr von Stoyer, supreme commander of German armed forces today called an unprecedented press conference to announce, "Internal order is of primary importance in the maintenance of external peace. Order will prevail in Germany! If the Kaiser cannot maintain order with those forces available to him, martial law will be declared and troops will be drawn from reserves to keep the peace."

((Berlin, Germany, July 12, 1905))

Juice freak and professional hippy, Herr Cote was wed today in the first "flower" ceremony in German history. The wedding was a disgrace reported roving reporter Ryan Bibby of the Spartan Daily Barf. He said that just about everyone freaked out when they played the processional music. (The Jefferson Luftwaffe is being sued by members of the area for breaking 3000 panes of glass by the numerous loud sounds(?) heard throughout the day) After the ceremony was over in which 4 couples were married, everyone to everyone else, the post union orgy, or reception occurred. This too was attended by Ryan Bibby who reported that it was shocking. After about an hour when he was invited to join in, his reports changed to ones that could not be cyphered out by our staff. It seems Ryan ran into Guru George Files, who was pushing Acid, and his objectivity seems to have been lost.

The happy groom, Herr Cote that is, could not be reached for comment, he was too far gone. His bride, the well proportioned, if not very well washed, Gretchen Goodbody, former maid to the

Paris, France, January 1, 1906 (UPI)

The participants seemed totally unabashed by our entrance and continued as if we weren't there. We then waded through the squirming libertinos and after much shifting and prying located Piethere at the very center of the heap."

The good Inspector Blocks then went on to tell about the surroundings: "The room itself was beyond belief. The walls were totally obscured by a sort of collage--a potpourri of low and lascivious paintings, photogravures, etchings and drawings. Pornographic books and paraphernalia were everywhere. Various unmentionable objects were displayed in the most shocking manner on shelves racks and stands; erotic statues in highly obscene positions were scattered about."

Among the items confiscated in the raid were whips, switches, leather and rubber clothing, barrels, racks, a menage of animals, and a ton of PUMPKINS.

With the arrest of "Filthy" Felix and his group not only has the most morally degenerate gathering since the Hell Fire Club been broken up, but police officials feel confident that production and sale of pornography will drop 90%, child molesting 80%, Sodomy 70% and other forms of sexual aberration and deviation at least 60%! PRESS RELEASES

January 11, 1904 London, England

Alfred Lord Duddly gave his annual report to the House of Commons today.  
 He reported on recent military moves and the dreaded V. D. plague still running  
 wild in Europe.

The Prime Minister has conferred with King Louie LXIX for over an hour in  
 Brest, where he was discovered in mid-orgy in a peasant's pig sty-combination  
 brothel. The King was very cross about the visit of the British fleet and feared  
 the sailors would spread their own form of V.D. throughout France. Admiral Moerle,  
 in charge of the British 4th fleet, was deeply insulted as he paid the swineherd

April 1, 1904, (Haward, Mass)

May 7, 1904, ((Bohemia))

ERDPOP results:

The newlyfreed citizens of Bohemia were asked about the rule of the Russian invaders. The peasants questioned reported that although most of the young girls were still virgins, their sons could not make the same statement.

France, April 1, 1904

As the French government prepares to leave for Sweden we wish to those infamous dogs Locke and Lord Dodo a pox upon their houses. May their alliance be as fruitful and as long as the Russo-Anglo Alliance.

January 1, 1904, Athens Greece

The last Austrian stronghold on the Greek mainland fell today to Turkish forces. The Austrians had abandoned their guard in order to repair to their New Year's celebration, assuming that the Turks would do likewise. Unfortunately for the Austrians, none had the brains to realize that the Islamic New Year falls on March 21.

At midnight the fortress was invaded and overrun. Many of the Austrian officials were caught in various acts of /CENSORED/.

In another room, evidences were found that Count Dracula had been present. All mirrors had been broken, and the Count's favorite drink, a bloody Mary was found on the bar. Efforts were made to revive the poor girl by Turkish medical officers.

An extensive search was made, but the Count could not be found. Only a large bat was seen, looping wildly overhead in the direction of Bistritz.

Heraklion, Crete, January 10, 1904,

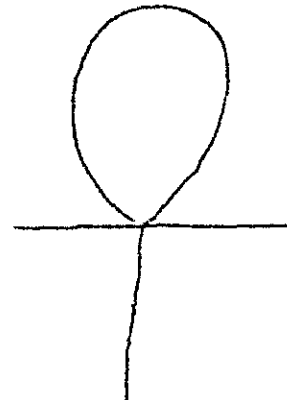
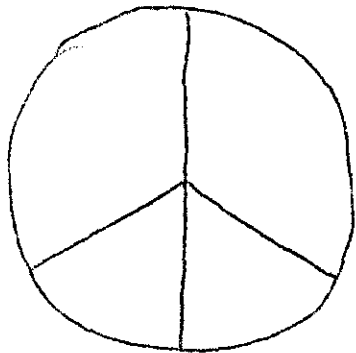
