((Vienna, Austria)) January 3, 1906

A group of Kiev engineers have completed a model of the D-1 Zeppelin. The first tests have been made to define its durability and aerodynamic properties. PRESS RELEASES

Constantinople, Turkey: September 8, 1904

The Turkish General Staff was overjoyed at the Turkish victory in Serbia. A victory celebration was held to which Count Dracula was invited. The invitation was declined when the Count learned it was to include "stake" dinner.

Sofia, Bulgaria: November 12, 1904

Turkish forces today invaded Rumania. No malice is harbored toward the Russians, but in view of recent Russian moves, the invasion was described as mercy killing.

Somewhere in Bohemia: July 7, 1904

Count Dracula narrowly escaped death today as a grotesque, foul smelling ogre entered the royal palace and attempted to kill him. Spwildinger, Prussia; January 21, 1906 (GNP):

Washington D.C.; 23 December 1905 (Gardener Press):

In a grim Christmas Eve message, the President announced an all night session of Congress, asking that war be declared against the Franco-Prussian Axis. Hun attacks on innocent Austria brought about this long delayed measure. Informed military sources state that mobilization orders have been prepared and that the Pacific fleet has already left Manila, sailing for Vladivostok. Lapel buttons with slogans like "The Kaiser is a One-Armed Bandit" and "Kick France's Pants" are the rage throughout the country. When late editions of the newspapers bearing the President's speech appeared, long lines of volunteers were seen in front of armed forces recruiting stations. Numerous notables were contacted in order to learn their reaction to the probable entrance of the US into the war. The French Premier was perched atop the Eiffle Tower (supposedly communing with Astral Powers), and the Kaiser was unavailable for comment as he was interviewing a new upstairs maid. 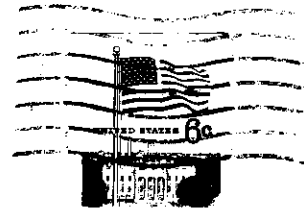
