A note from John Beshara:

I have written John Beshara recently concerning a vile letter printed by him attacking, in the most vulgar way, Mr. Rod Walker -- hief of the N3F DD. I made a protest to the concil of the DA over this letter and called it to the attention of the board that the author of such a letter was not, in my opinion, fit material for the chairmanship of the Diplomacy association. In addition I commented on the first WAZIR & supprted the three proposals made on page one. John asked if I will publically endorse these three goals, and I do wholeheartedly! However:

"You previousl indicated to me you would not publicay support TDA or plug it in your publications until you had evidence of its worthiness -- I am not quoting you directly, that is my recollection of your general feeling. Will you now give us this public support which you previously denied us?"

The answer is NO. Not until full election by-laws and a membership of the DA is printed and made available to the general membership. The current board is semi-competant I am sure. But they are ruling by devine right at the moment. They have been appointed(?) by no higher authority. I will suppor the DA when the founding fathers let go of the apron strings and turn the project over to the members. If after elections the same 6 men run DA I will support it when I feel the interest of postal diplomacy are being fostered, as in the three

proposals made in WAZIR number one. I shall not support it if it continues to be run by an arismtocratic elite-- I refer to Mr. Beshara-for we have heard NOTHING from any member of the board, just Mister

----I would ask how Mister Buchanon also inherits the devine right to choose, to govern, or to do anything? After all, "it's new, it's for you" If the committee chairman approves it? Where are all of these rules ONE PAPER so we THE MEMBERS OF THE DA may see them? How can an organization, such as this one claims to be, be so damn arbitrary and lofty. Who elected Walter Buchanon? Who appointed Walter Buchanon? Please note, I do not object to Walt personally, I am sure he is quite. competant, and I do not question his credentials to be upon the board, I just want to know how he got on the boards.

" As to your other inquiries, those are matters for the Board and when a determination is made it will be announced in the WAZIR, where all members will receive the news simultaneously. Might I ask the reasons for your "interest" in inquiring when elections will be helD?" rapidly as an election could spirit you out of office. Beard has NO RIGHT to determine ANYTHING! Where do these six people get off running this organization and making laws by which it shall run? Daily business, production of the WAZIR must be done by a few until organization is achieved. But POLICY AND ORGANIZATION, the board has NO SUCH AUTHORITY OR RIGHT!

"There are a couple (of) items in your letter that might be desirable to quote in our next publication:

'I fully support all three of the proposals outlined on page

1 of the Hay issue of the WAZIR'.

the idea of the 'tactical quiz' in the May issue of the WAZIR is excellent, As an old bridge palyer, I can appreciate the format of such a presentation."

YOU have my permission, as I do endorse these proposals and I urge the membership to legitimise them via a vote, or urge that the elected board make them top on the priority list of officall DA functions!!

"The article you referred to, published in GRAUSTARK 238, was written by me. It is not connected with TDA. When I became an officer ((howdid you do that?)) of TDA I did not give up my American birthright, including any of my rights as an individual.
