Question: (situation is changed so that questioner is not revealed)

IF Austria: A VIE-gal, Russia A WAR-gal but Italy orders A tyo-vie, what happens? i.e. Is Austrian A Vie still in place?

Yes it is in place, because A TYO-vie. An army (fleet) that does not succeed in its order does not give up its right to its base of origin. It must be dislodged by a force(s) superior in number to all other forces (if any) also attacking that space. A piece ordered to move can not be supported in place if it fails in its order, thus A TRIE (s) A VIE is invalid because A vie is ordered to move (OTM).
