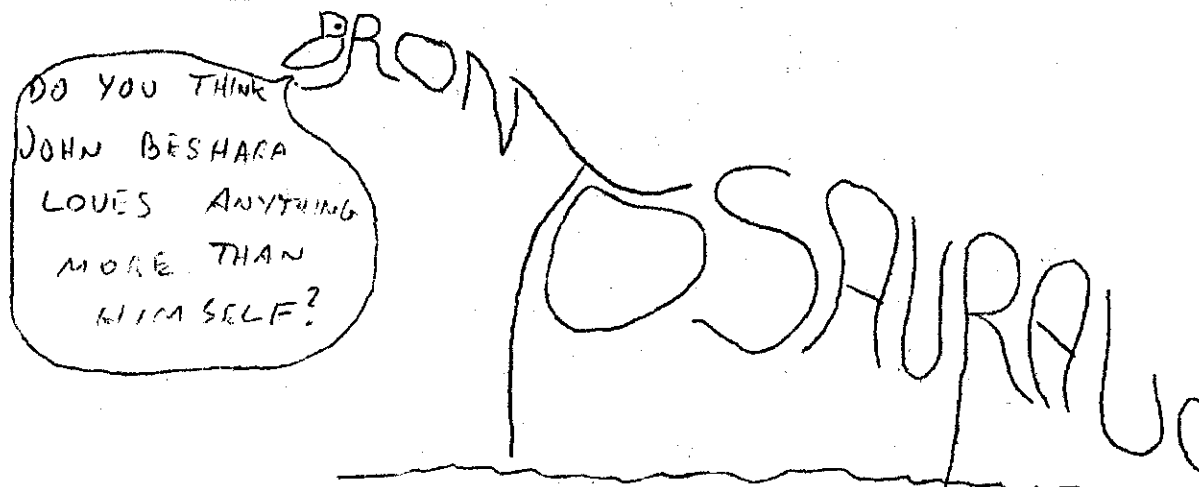


# LIAISONS DANGEREUSES 22
