

Robert Strayer and Pete Weber,....have agreed to take on the job of revitalizing the IFWDS and soliciting new members, etc. as we discussed. ...it would be better to have them handle the work load, ... Both impressed me and I think Strayer can do a good job if you give him some good advice. /S/ Larry -----At the moment Mr. Strayer and Mr. Weber may handle the work of reorganization of the IFWDS. I shall be in contact with them in the next few days to lay plans. Basically I want to collect NO DUES (fees) of any kind until at least January 1 1971 os that member interest can be recorded and what the members want in an organization. This organization WILL BE of and by the members! Be it clearly understood that Mr. Strayer and Mr. Weber will act in a temporary capacity until elections can be held in January. To obtain an IFW Charter we must have a remaine constitution and MUS guarantee eelctions. I would like to see an organization that would sponsor Dipdomacy through convention events, PBM tournaments, instructional/advice booklets, current news etc. I personally do not beleive that a Diplomacy organization should mess with the rules or rule interpretations in an official capacity. An organization can recomment rules and interpretations. It can give a cross reference of all game openings by the rules used, so that the player knows before hand what ruels are being used, and what rules, if any, will not be 'rated' by various gamemasters who handle these functions. All players are encouraged to contact Mr. Strayer (207 E. Alice St., Phoenix Ariz. 85020) and give him your opinions. Mr. Peery, Walker, Buchanon et.al.are advisors to the IFWDS ONLY.

Though you took a kill little trouble with your "Leonard Lakofka" hoax than I did with "Eric Blake", I think the time to stop pretending has come. I have no doubt that you have arranged this so that there is a perfectly genuine "Leonard Lakofka" who could come forward with a social Security card and all the rest of the requisite identification of our times, if challenged.
