





An open letter to Mr. Wolf, Pieloch and Myan -- and all players who may benefit. Alas, not everyone can win the game of Diplomacy in which he is playing. Yet, since you have paid your game fee you should continue to play. In addition you owe the other players something! They want to enjoy the game as much as you do. Yet when you drop out and throw play-balance to hell and back you ruin the game for them. Part of the ego trip in Diplomacy is winning by skill and craft. If your opponent (or worse, your ally) just ups and drops dead on you the game loses some of its fun and flavor. It should also be noted that if you plan to play in other Diplomacy games that your failure to finish other games will hurt you! If you are a quitter why should someone else ally with you? Look at 1971 DV in this magazine. Russia was handed a win on a silver platter when Brian Kelly could not get his act together and either move or at least resign. Brian ruined the game for Harry Drews because maybe Harry could have gotten a 3 way draw out of it. REMEMBER A DRAW IS NOT A LOSS. 2nd place is a loss, as is any position in which you do not win or draw. Even with a few pieces you can sometimes draw. At least you can befriend an ally or get revenge on an enemy. If you just quit you throw your game fee away, and you take some of the fun out of the game for someone else. Let's ALL get our moves in next time, okay?

Note especially the Italian position. Greece can not be protected from Turkish capture. If Bul is bounced Aeg is lost. If Acg is bounced Gre goes by default. However, Aeg can be contested. A Gre can not, after all, support F Con-Aeg! Further observe the tri-power cooperation move; A Ber-Sil, A Mun-Boh With A Vie, A Gal does not move. A Ven-Tyo. This destroys The Austrian A Boh and the threat of the piece. This pair of moves gives Italy excellent play. His real move A Tri(s)R A Cal-Boh(NSO!). A Ven(s) ATril?, F Ion Gre, F Nap-Ion doomed him in later play.

It should be noted that the Austrian piece prevented an earlier attack on Russia and that piece of dying by Edi Birson changed the entire course of the game! Who said one piece can't matter?
