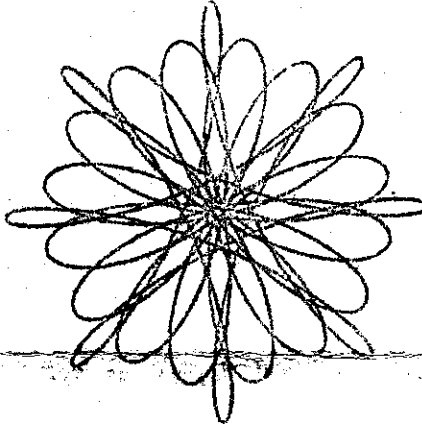

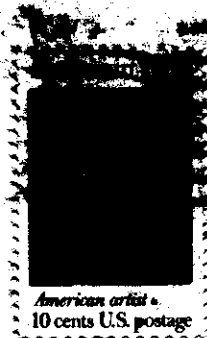

2. It has been my experience that Air Mail overseas takes from 3 to 4 days and rarely takes 5 or 6. Mr. Johnson has not asked for deadline extensions and I will not consider them until it can be shown that he is being hurt by the shorter deadlines preferable for a demonstration game.
3. As I have said moves dependant on the same season are unacceptable. Vacations and business trips not with standing it is up to the player to plan whether he is able to play in a game or whether he will be away most of the time and can not engage in active Diplomacy.
4. Press releases that are really negotiations are not acceptable, they just waste magazine space. Black Press is acceptable IF IT HAS NOTHING TO DO WITH THE GAME, thus satire is quite acceptable but material about the movement of pieces etc. would not be printed under another's dateline. Mr. Johnson did not author the last "Warsaw".
5. I would appreciate it if you would not make comments on my analysis until after the game is over. I do not wish to have my brilliant analysis muddled with facts!
