PRESS RELEASES

Rome, Sept. 19: Today the king made one of his rare public appearences and speeches in Rome today. As thousands of hisbeloved followers watched in awe, he spoke out

ASSASSIN ESCAPES

Vienna, Austria (Dec. 23, 1901) (AVCL): The Austrian Intelligence Agency was forced to admit that one of the recently captured British spy ring members had escaped custody almost immediately. Chief of the AIA, Count Von Kevenstadion irately denied that stupidity, carelessness or bumbling had anything to do with the escape: "That Exlax is speedy, that's all, and we weren't fast enough on our feet to make it to the WC (Warning Controls) before he'd acted. Now we have our...er..hands full. Frankly, I must admit that it is doubtful if we will take Exlax again."

Paris, France, Jan. 1, 1902: At a news conference today, King Louis made a momenttous announcement. Said the King: "People of France, today marks the beginning of a new order. The world will know it as S.T.U.P.I.D. (Stupied things undertaken phor intimidation, duh...). We shall bring the new order to the peoples of the world if necessary, by force." The King usually noted for his famous oratories, did not elaborate.

Constantinople, Turkey--Jan. 7, 1902-- A total of 300 Austrian spies have been captured here since the first of the month. The group, specially trained by Count Willie Von Fluffy was easily caught due to their offensive use of the Turkish language. It seems they only speak in the genital...er..genitive case. Trial will begin Monday but children under 16 will not be admitted.

Damascus, Syria--Feb. 2, 1902: The 1902 Winter Olympics were brought under way here today. The chill temperature of 80 degrees was the coldest yet reported in Damascus. Total casualities were 99 Austrians and two Austrailian spectators with speach impediments. All Europe now looks forward to the Summer Olympics, to be held in Murmansk Russia.

Vienna, Austria (Apr. 10, 1902): Austrian agents of the Austrian Secret Service have reportedly penetrated the inner precincts of Italy's Foreign Office in Rome and successfully transmitted WOP Top secret information to their superiors in Vienna. The 347 page document smuggled from Italy outlined Italy's foreign policies in depth. The most amazing revelation of the manuscript revealed that Italy and England, who have "a very strong alliance" were in discussion of war plans in "teh forthcoming was against France." The English fleet in London is to move to the English Channel, supported by Fleet North Atlantic, while the English Army in the north of England was to move south to London in readiness to convoy! Austrian spokesman said later that "It is hoped England will not undertake such a foolish maneuver...theconsequences would be very dire indeed in the cause of world peace." The spokesman went on to say the Austrian diplomats were even now in council with Lord Dudley and o ther top English statesman, in an attempt to dissuade them from this most egregious error.

Wilfred Micdaffy was, as usual, baffled. After a great deal of investigation all that could be found in common among the crimes were the letters V.D. etched on the foreheads of the victims.

Somewhere in Rumania(Feb. 17, 1902) Heineous crimes were the rule throughout Rumania this week as numerous cases of homocide were reported with the same symbol V.D. enblazoned on the victims foreheads!

Paris, France (Mar. 17, 1902) All of Europe is in a state of panic as the mysterious V.D. murders have traveled to Belgium, Greece, Italy, France and last night-to Amsterdam. Even during these times of war police all over Europe are working together.

Berlin, Germany (Mar, 31, 1902): Tonight a most blood curdling and frightening sound was heard on Marconi's wireless, what few such sets do exist. Through the garble and crackle the following baratone voice was heard: "I am the voice of doom. Europe shall cringe at the sound of my name! Soon I and the victorious armies I represent shall Truimph over Europe. All the world shall be under the curse of V.D.!"

Geneva, Switzerland (April 1, 1902) Heads of all the governments of Europe met today in one common cause, to wipe out V.D. on the continent! In a closed session they appointed their best agents to fight this evil foe. They were given the code name of Penny Silons, champions of justice!

Iondon, England (May 11, 1902): Alfred Lord Dudley met with British agents headed by Geodfrey Laklopka, who had escaped from a Viennese prison a week ago, During the meeting Austrian Count Willie Von Fluffy burst into the room and attempted to assassinate Laklopka. Luckily it was an Austrian fire are and it exhibited typical Austrian craftmanship and pride and exploded, wounding Von Fluffy. No comment was forthcoming from British officials.


Lake Geneva, Wis. U.S.A. (May 30, 1902): Cnidarian specialist and American Ambassador Polyp N. Chardprit was called on by Alfred Lord Dudley to help Britain in a secret mission. Charprit did not want to leave the convention he was attending but Phoney Morale of Italy and Turkish emisary Akbar ahmed Pulp persuaded him to leave. Just as they were about to go the body of their host, Larry Guygax, was found murdered in his home with the letters V.D. on his forehead.

Vienna, Austria (June 27, 1902): In a daring escape from the city jail, which required intricate planning and timing E.G. Exlax, W D Cloyer, P.N. Preacher and S. Sunken were all successfully spirited out of the hands of the A.S.S. agent Wilfred Micdaffy. One of the group who freed the British and allied agents, Akbar ahmed Pulp was killed in the attempt. Everyone is specualting on the reason for so daring a maneuver!

London (June 29, 1902): Ambassador Polyp N. Chardprit, P.M. Alfred Lord Dudley and E.G. Exlax gave a full account of the mustery involving the Austrian escape. Exlax told that he and his fellow agents had uncovered most sinister plot to overthrow all of Europe. "Although I was sure that Austrian agents played a large part in the plans, other powers must also have been in on it. The plan involved the use of an appointed killer who would use the code name of the "Voice of Doom." Their plan was to so terrify Europe so as to mask the movements and intents of their alliance until their armies had struck! So for all that was sure was that Austria was trying to play off the nations of Europe, one against the other so she could act as a free agent, supposedly friend to all but actually lurking and waiting her chance. Both Turkey and Italy-her first victims. have been warned, but it may be too late! Russia and Turkish forces and Italian nad French armies are so deeply embroiled that they may need proof of Austria's evil intent. We have it on good authority that Austria will strike at Turkey and move into Tyr..." The room was blacked out and a scream was heard. When they got the lights on again Polyp N. Chardprit was badly wounded and Exlax had given his all. V.D. had struck again!

DIPLOMACY DIOCRACY by Lucien L*Heureux

We will attempt to analyse((sic)) the physical attributes of the different countries on the Diplomacy board. Let me point out that these features are constant. The whims and fancies of players involved will either add or subtract to these fundamental conditions, but remember that they exist and differ widely from country to country. Let us begin with the nation which has perhaps the best geographical position defensively and the worst offensively.

ENGLAND

The understanding of the composite and surrounding features of a country is of prime importance in conducting the best battle possible and it also aids greatly in conducting diplomacy. England is surrounded by bodies of water; has two near neighbors, France and Germany. Also a remote neighbor, Russia. Note that England has a 1901 build expectancy of one. The North Sea and English Channel are a natural line of defense and attack. One of the big advantages is that England can only be invaded by or through the use of fleets. Such invasion can be detected easily enough by observing France's and Germany's fleet movements. This is also true with regard to Russia, who's northern fleets could pose a threat. Also, the nature of their builds and the locations also bear watching.

Fleets in Brest, and Kiel and/or St. Petersburg (N.C.) may indicate a storm coming up. Your diplomacy should aim at the discouraging of such builds, encouraging your neighbors to concentrate on armies. It is possible that France will need fleets in the Mediterranean in order to pursue a policy of British urged expansion in that area. Be sure to keep such fleets out of a "neutral" Mid-Atlantic. I am of the opinion that the moment England posseses four naval units she should prove a very tough nut to crack for any opponent—even a coordinated attack by France and Germany. The North Sea is the heart of England's defense. Without it's possesion you have what probably amounts to a dead country. At no time during the game should control of it be relinquished! Likewise, the Irish Sea is the rear door, and if France becomes too powerful you should take necessary measures to prevent her entry there. Attack from this body of water could disorganize your entire game plan, or worse, bring total defeat!

If the seas are England's ally it is also quite a burden for expansion plans. Let's examine the attack problem. You have to get supply centres. This means getting onto and into the continent or nibbling at its edges. HOW? Through beach heads. England has a natural one in Norway, but it is too far removed from the center point of action to serve as an entree into Europe, generally. Using it as such necessitates operations far away from critical areas. To keep a force there is fairly difficult but not impossible. Continued occupation of the North Sea and/or English Channel is a must. Nibbling-taking Norway, Holland, Belgium, Brest, Spain, or Portugal--is workable but a risky strategy as you are too spread out and vulnerable.

Here, on a general basis, are the prerequisits of successful play for England:
1) aim early at two builds 2) make them fleets 3) get that beach head 4) keep a close watch on your opponent's fleets before denuding any area 5) keep control and possession of North Sea and 6) reinforce your beach head as soon as possible.

Naturally, your diplomatic ability will affect these requirements.

An attack on England proper can usually be handled easily with only a pair of fleets at sea and two armies at home. Liverpool and Yorkshire, both bordering on four of your six home provinces. are key areas for defensive armies. Although all English provinces have sea coasts, they border on only five bodies of water.

A word to the wise: An English-Italian alliance should be cought, while hostilitles between Germany and France are promoted. Am Italian army in Piedmont will more or less hamstring France and discourage any belligerent attitude toward you. It will also make it easier to acquire Belgium. If you can get German consent, after all it helps them in their struggle against France! or even their support it is so much the better for you.

Remember, England is in an excellent defensive position, but she must gain supply centers as early as possible if she hopes to win. Above all, guard that North Sea at all times.
