

Dear Len;

Edi (Bixsan) called last week and requested that GenCon withdraw its bid for DipCon in the interest of DIPLOMACY. He stated that Origins wished to begin advanced publicity, and if we maintained our bid no decision could be made until March, thus hurting IDA/Dippy press. As it seems clear that GenConstands only an outside chance at best for DipCon IX, and our bid was made primarily to establish us as a serious consideration for future DipCons, we agreed. This means that we will put in a strong bid for 1977, and we will begin our publicity for this bid IMMEDIATELY. Can we expect your support and aid? We would like to work with you on this.

Meanwhile, plans for a fantasy battle at GenCon can now proceed. Let us know what day will suit you best, times, etc.

Naturally it is unfortunate that IDA did not get its DipCon committee moving more rapidly so that a vote could in fact be taken. But Gary has bowed out with the promise of a great convention for 1977. I have attended 5 of the 8 GenCons and all of those have been superb--the last, Gen Con VIII had an attendance of over 1,000!

I have suggested to Gary a team event using a single elimination system--as we did in 1971 at Gen Con for an armor team game.
