8 TH ANNIVERSARY ISSUE next time! Yes we have been in business now for 8 long years. Most of them have been fun but frankly it is getting to be a bore. It is not that I do not enjoy the game, DIPLOMACY is one of the best games around, it is the people that are getting to be a pain in the ass. Again, it is not the vast majority--many of the people who begin as novices in LD have gone on to become prominent in the hobby, the new recruits are all as enthusiastic as ever and seem to be enjoying the game as much as ever. However, there is a certain fringe group who constantly try to screw up the hobby in the name of procedure and bureaucracy. The current crop is headed by Ben Grossman, Greg Costikyan and John Leeder--with honorable mentions to Robert Sacks and Raymond Heuer.

AS many of know we have been trying to reorganize the IDA to make it more useful to the members of the organization. The above five have tried to hamper those efforts from day one. It would have been well enough if, after the election campaign in which 'the Democrats' waged, in my opinion, a questionable campaign, these people then tried to help the HOBBY. Instead they have decided to create a crisis over WHO was elected president. These tin Ghods of Diplomacy have decided that the British votes should have counted in the election. They ran a telephone poll of the 'Council' in which an outright lie was told to the members casting their votes. They notified no one of the result of this spurious poll but published a DIPLOMACY REVIEW instead announcing Ray Heuer as president! (To keep perspective Grossman and Costikyan are being spoken of so far.) When the Council members found the true facts some changed their votes.
