DIPLOMACY -- DIOCRACY

Lucien L'Hereux

GERMANY Germany is mostly an inland power with bodies of water to the west and north. It has four neighbors, England, France, Austria and Russia. Its normal building potential is two., these will be discussed in the text of the country proper.

Germany has both an external and internal strength. The internal strength consist for the physical configuration of the supply centers. The external one is of a psychological order but maybe of a more

powerfuil nature yet.

The form of the supply centers is in the shape of a wheel, kiel being the Rub, Holland, Denmark, Berlin and Munich the spokes. The rim is then formed by the provences surrounding the spokes. Now a wheel is only as strong as its hub. Remove it and everything will collapse under pressure. It does, from the above, become imperablye to evaluate this point. It is next to impossible to destroy it early in the game. Normally it will benefit from the support of any free spokes, others willprevent or fight off the approaches to it, not to mention the nature of the rim which protects indirectly. One

thing to remember is that in order to fill its role completely am army must occupy it! a fleet would not assist Mun or protect Ruhr.

The spokes benefit from their mutual assistance capability with the hab. In order to have an estimate of the potential of the "spokes" it is necessary to study the following conditions and situations.

How many avenues of approach are there to each one? What is the quality and quantity of the defensive value of the spokes? And, most important, how important is the "psychological factor", which I shall explain now.

If we observe the countries surrounding the spokes we see that they have conflicting interests, especially in the East. This fact plus others more remote, prevents coordination of attack against the spokes which would be necessary to hit the spokes with any efficacity. I will analyze one of the spokes for you and you may go all around the others in a similiar manner, if you so desire.

Munich has five avenues of approach, namely TYR, BOH, SIL, BUR, + BUHR. It has three defensive factors, itself, BER and KIEL. It would see, a priori, to be an easy target. But this is false, Why? Look east!

Russia and Austria can't coordinate their efforts too well due to conflicting interests. They also have to take Italy and Turkey into consideration. This should eliminate one of the two aggressors. What is more likely or possible is a French-Russian or an Austraan-French attack. How effective would this be?

Were Austria to have an army in TYR and France one in Burg Mun could easily be defended by Kiel +/o Ber. If Austria now adds A Boh and France A Ruh (possible but difficult) we will note that a great deal of time has been expended and a great deal of force was needed to get to this point. Germany, as a rule, will have time to increase its defense to maximum. From this I would say that the moment Germany has four armies it is very powerful defensively.

The problem then is as follows. You do need to compromise on expansion. If inland operation is desired, than you require more armies. This does insure maximum security. The trouble with land operation is that an invasion of France is slow and other countries might benefit from it more than you. Attacking east will destroy the psychological protection you benefit from normally. In the case of an alliance with Austria such a move may be feasable, however, youhave to think of Eng Ch and France in such a course of action. Attacking west or north requires water operation. This will delay the obtaining of the necessary army needed to increase your security to a maximum.

Your south border is well protected, your east has build in protection your west and north coast are the more vulnerable. Here is where the slogan "the best defense is a good offense" applies. Before we leave the western front I would like to discuss the status of Belgium.

Besides being an added center for the possessor, it brings a great deal to whomever holds it. It is of a strategic nature, it can also be classified as what I call a "critical point". English possession will will give England her much needed fifth center and a beach head right in the middle of the action. French possession gets a bonus in the form of a much more secure Burg while increasing its own expansion possibilities. If Germany acquires it then it completely secures its Southern border and increases Holland's security. Of the three involved, France stands to lost the most from the loss of it as it periously weakens Burg and thus great care must be applied to protect that point after its loss, just to produce a secure internal position but one that is quite cramped.

As German ruler you are the fucky possessor of a country that has very few weaknesses. Be careful not to destroy your built-in assets

by ill considered moves. Get those four armies as soon as possible. Aim a creating possibilities of attack where you are the weakest. Do not forget diplomacy because you have a strong position, while you have a position which can be easily defended you would loose expansion possibilities by doing so and would eventually fall under the sheer weight of the surrounding countries.

Jan. 17, 1901-Brooklyn, N.Y. UPI

The New York Times reported today that the deportation trial of reputed Mafia boss Anthonio "Tony the Sicilian" Morali, and his Underboss, Phillippi "Pizza Phil" Pritcharde, ended in their conviction. The trial was iniciated at the insistance of FBI director J. Edgar Hoyer, who was the government's star witness. The two Mafioso leaders will be deported next month to Parlemo, Sicily.

June 25, 1901; - Rone, Italy, Reuters

After 6 months of revolution, the forces of Antonio "Tony the Sicilian" Norali, and his Underboss, Phillippi "Pizza Phil" Pritchardi, and 10,000 Mafioso, captured Rome Today. Mafia boss Morali, deported 6 months ago from the U.S., has taken over the government. His new programs, according to the Mafia spokesmen, will beput into effect immediately. The old Italain government fell when the body of the Prime Minister was found floating in the Po River.

July 1, 1901 -- Rome, Italy, Reuters

In his first major speech, Mafia Boss Anthonio Morali, Alais "Tony the Sicilian" promised the people of Italy a new program, including the legalization of gambling, 100 liras/week as employees of the Mafia, and the reinstatement of Italy to the former glories of Rome. The Italian Army underwent radical change, turning in their rifles for stillitoes and Violin Cases equipped with a new secret weapon. Phillippi Pritchardi, alias "Pizza Phil", will be new head of the Italian Army and will remain underboss to "Tony the Sicilian." A general reward of 1 million lira, is offered to the Mafioso who brings back the head of Elliot Ness!

July 2, 1901--Vatican City, Reuters

Pope Pussell Rowell declared himself a "prisoner of the Vatican." He vowed not to step outside the Vatican walls until the Maria agrees to give the Church a cut of the rackets, such as the receipts from the Bingo nights!

July 3, 1901--New York Times

Cub reported John Bor ck, in an exclusive interview with Mafia boss Antonic Morali, who is now Chief of State of the Italian government, reported that the Italian government wishes peace in Europe. The following is the exact interview:

Bobeck: "Is it true that the reason the Italian government wishes peace is that it wants to preserve its worldwide rackets?"

A. Morali: "We all gotta eat, right?"

Bobeck: Why were you and Pizza Phil deported from the U.S.?"

- Morali: We was deported because the Feds couldn't send us up the river, so they did the next best thing!"
- J.B.: "How did Pizza Phil get his nickname?"
- Morali" Once while we was in Chicago, he dropped a Pizza on himself while we were eating in Ecue's, Ever since then, he's been known as Pizza Phil!"
- J.B.: "If war breaks out in Europe, what does the Italian government plan to do?"
- Morali: "The Mafia will not take an active part in the actual war, but will sell war goods, as well as our usual items, to all countries. God help the Head of any foreign government that crosses me, as Phil here will give him the kiss of death."

Sept. 17, 1904 Paris, France

A 3 act play was presented today by the Federated Organization of Actors headed by director Sparky Fencer. The play featured a series of characters who resembled Richard Steal III of Pittsburg, Pope Pussell Rowell of Greece and Italian Military leader Danelli Halfflower. The prices for seats were ridicously high and as the play progressed the nausea of all who watched grew rapidly. When it was over many left the theater puzzled that such a piece of trash could be foisted off on the public. The play cast aspersions on many and Phoney Morale, Pill Prithurd, W.D Voyeur, Pope Pussell, Leo leCupcake and Daneli Halfflower have all filed suit against the F.O.A. for slander.

When Policeman Hansi Krueger went to arrest Fencer they found the F.O.A. was a dummy organization and Fencer was just trying to make a buck and get his name in lights. It is! Every Post Office in Europe has a well lit photo of him in it: Reward: 1¢, but then most just wish he'd disappear.

((Rome Italy)) Oct. 14, 1904

King Mikul, the dumb, celebrated his 8th birthday today. His new regent, Sparky Fencer, read a series of royal proclamations to the assembled nobility of Italy (a retired street sweeper, chimney sweep Jon Bobecki, a few of his fathers prior consorts...er maids, and a Pizza king from Naples).

After he got through with syntactically succinct diatribe which even for the King was a bit garish, the audience was "awed" or so reported the Italina News Service, Wonderful Organized Press.

However W.O.P did not report all of the facts. Ryan Bibby, posing as a sculerry maid, entered the royal chambers (which he flushed after using (, and then snuck into the throne room (the king was on "the pot" at the time) so he finally made it to the grand audience chamber when Sparky read the proclamation. Bibby siad that combined talent of the King and Mr. Fencer totally exhibited their combined IQ of about 17.

UNHOLY ALLIANCE CONTINUES

Washington D.C. 11 November 1904 Gardener Press: Despite predictions that the Franco-Prussian pact for world domination would not last, latest reports from Europe indicate that this monstrous combination malignly persists. Although French hatred for the Hun is as prevalent as ever, and German contempt for the Gauls is if anything more widespread, both peoples evidentally have a still stronger emotion motivating them: Greed for Power: French agression on hapless Italy and the current German attacks on their former Russian friends starkly highlight past atrocities performed by them in England. Attempts by Italy, Russia and Turkey to settle differences with Austria-Hungary and present a united front to the Paris-Berlin axis have met with sharp rebuffs from Franz Jesef despite the fact that Austria obviously is the next nation to be raped.

Conditions in Europe have aroused strong sentiment here in the East for US intervention to prevent further warfare and distress. If this demand becomes national the President will be hard pressed to justify his isolationist stand to an aroused American Public.

Constantinople, Turkey 18 December 1904 UPI: A major change in the Turkish Imperial Cabinet was announced today by his Omnipotence Sultan Omar II. The new ministers, all octogenerians (thus "Old Turk") include:

As the new cabinet may be indicative of a forthcoming change in Turkish War policy foreign observers will be carefully watching the diplomatic barometer.

Press Releases: May 1, 1903 Zughalten on the Russian-Austrian Border
Head of RUF Mikhail Konlonovitch uncovered a dasterdly plan here today to

10 April. 1903 Buda-Posth DAMN

The reign of the new emperior has started out with his showing how much he considers the welfare of his people. In one of his first acts, Count Dracula has ordered that all the roads of the realm were to be improved, to aid travel, communications and commerce. A strange note was added the, with the further Imperial Order that has started the construction of small, mausoleum-like buildings a day's journey apart along the highways. There is much speculation over their purpose.

25 April. 1903 Vienna HELL

The new Imperial Decree has started much speculation in diplomatic circle, suggesting that the Austria-Hungarian Emperior might be a bit exxentric. For it was ordered today that throughout the Empire all mirrors were to be broken, all corsses on churches and other buildings were to be covered over and from this day forward, the possession of herb garlic would be considered a capital offense, punishable by instant death. The populate seems to be taking these odd orders quietly, although private sources report the organization of a Black Market in Garlic and Crucifixes.

4 May, 1903 Bistritz HELL

Our agent Johann Bummbek, has now opened our new office here in the city of Bistritz, Transylvannia the new capital, of the Austria-Hungarian Emprie.
