I have had players offer me "clippings" of their "trustworthiness as a sales pitch. Also beware lest the often crazy results of trying to hold a rep be interpreted as a grudge move, a cross-game alliance or a "favor" of some sort. Nothing upsets the fun-loving stabber like witnessing (or thinking he is witnessing) an outside event effecting the flow of the game.

One last, but extremely important point: As an example, suppose you are playing Austria, when Turkey and Russia immediately come rushing at you together. Now, Turkey happens to be a trustworthy player with a rep to think of, while Russia is just a fun-lover who honors an alliance like the 55 MPH speed limit. What do you do? Obviously you throw everything at Turkey, while promising Russia Bulgaria, Constantinople, a Big Mac, or anything else that comes to mind. Because he is the player most likely to take advantage of the situation and jump at his former ally.

Now, don't get the idea that I am encouraging unnecessary blood-shed, or trying to create enmity among my opponents. I simply wanted to show the other side of the coin. Perhaps I am guilty of excessive elaboration in a few points, but I still maintain that a rep OF ANY SORT is not the best idea, as it seems to cut your friends by half. Just go out there, have fun, mix in a few "beautiful moves" with your play, and worry not about who you might offend. Anyone you do offend is not worthy of you alliance, anyway.

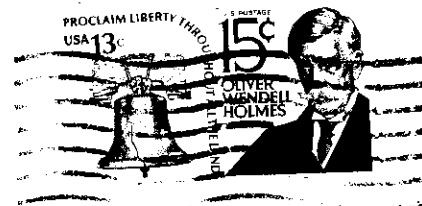
