

I am saddened to note that I have had to suspend James Hymas as Associate MNC for Special Projects. Hymas is being continued as Chief Variant Ratingmaster to the MNC, pending determination of the matter by the Deputy MNC for North America. A Deputy MNC advises the MNC and staff of information that they should know, and recommends changes in staff in his area. I am pleased to announce the appointment of Gregory Costikyan as 2nd Vice MNC and Deputy for North America. We are considering Hartley Patterson for acting Deputy MNC for Europe - he could recommend appointments for Deputy for Europe, Associate for Europe, and Associate for Orphans in Europe.

The post of Associate MNC for Special Projects has been reassigned. Duties include Executive Officer and acting Chairman of the Recategorization Project, Registrar of the Orphan Games Project, Registrar and acting Coordinator of the Variant Playtesting Service, and Editor of the Variant Handbook. The appointee is Robert Sacks - if you want something done right, you have to do it yourself.

The Orphan Games Project (North America) has been unified, and now handles regular, variant, and pseudo- Diplomacy and Origins games. Ray Heuer is Director and Associate MNC, and handles the determination of orphan status and the actual placement of orphans. Robert Sacks is Registrar and Associate MNC, and registers volunteers to take over as publisher, gm, or player for orphan games - specify number and type of games, please. In addition, the Variant Playtesting Service will be conducting feedback and playtests of variants so as to certify variants playable so that an insurance fund can be started.

Ray Heuer is interested in stepping aside as TDA Variants Officer. Persons interested in the post (which carries a seat on DVC, and responsibility for any questions posed to TDA on variants and the development of variant projects in TDA, not to mention a place on the target list of the hobby Establishment) should contact him.

I am trying to determine if a Federated Variant Bank (that will avoid the mistakes of the World Variant Bank) can get started. So far Robert Sacks as MNC, Ray Heuer as DVC Secretary, and Conrad von Metzke as DW Variants Editor have expressed interest - write me for details.

This year's Variant Award Panel is now being elected. I will probably be its Secretary - if not, I will forward any nominations - categories are publication, gamemaster, design, article, and general contribution, and possibly a special award.

As can be seen, Lord of Hosts now carries Miller Numbers, Heuer's Origins Numbers, and Phillies Numbers for pseudo-Diplomacy games. Games with von Metzke Numbers, Costikyan or Grossman Numbers, or Schwartz Numbers (you really don't want to know about those "efforts") should be reported to myself, Houer, or Phillies as appropriate for the assignment of a legitimate number, and publication here.

Back issues of <u>Lord of Hosts</u> through 586 are available at 20¢/number plus postage. From #T on, it is 25¢/number plus postage.

MIT-SGS WinterCon V took place, without adequate publicity - I showed up and served as Diplomacy Tournament scorekeeper. Best single performance was by a Mr Dougenik with a 13 center Russia and 4 survivors. The winner was Phil McGee with a 9 center Germany and a 9 center Turkey, followed by Drew McGee with a 10 center France and a 6 center Austria, and Richard Kovalcik with a a 7 center Turkey and a 7 center Russia. Games lasted 5 or 6 game years.

PSEUDO-DIPLOMACY REPORT: PHILLIES NUMBERS AND DESIGNATORS

There are also games run by Flying Buffalo, Inc., using their computer moderation system. One notes:

Nuclear Destruction: 464 games started to date, 517 active players.

Battle Plan: 475 games started to date, 457 active players.

Moon Base: 48 games, 40 players.

Board of Directors: 47 games, 56 players.

Raumkrieg: 17 games, 41 players. Time Trap: 12 games, 18 players.

Star Web: 30+ games, 200+ players.

For a total of more than 1000 games (of which more than 2/3 are completed games at this time.)

Flying Buffalo, Inc., which also has about 15 regular Diplomacy games being moderated, maintains the complete game records and rating systems for the Flying Buffalo games.

Madame Guillotine (Chris Ruffle, Fantasy Games Unlimited). In spite of the misspellings of Carnot as Carrot and Saint-Just as St. Juste, and the inclusion of an unknown Vincent as a major French revolutionary leader, this is a fine game (not a diplomacy variant) quite playable by mail. It is a game for up to six players in competition for a fixed number of victory points, each with his own victory level and death level for resentment points you can't avoid — in addition you can be killed off, but the player who kills you off gains a lot of resentment that way. The game has an Origins playing system with some features resembling The Brotherhood, and there is an option for dummy counters. The rules are unclear on a number of points, such as whether the attacked party in combat receives resentment points, whether the National Guard can be controlled when there is no Assembly controller, and whether a captured personality can bring additional forces into the Assembly or Tribunal to attempt to rescue himself.

p76.D Diplomatic Chess (Donald Wileman due to Pat & Ron Efron, Der Fliegende Holländer Vol 1 #6). A variant on chess - each side consists of Master, King, Queen, Engineer (for the rooks), 2 Bishops, & 2 Knights, each with varying prerogatives on which move is to be made. The game is altered to simultaneous movement with "In the event of a conflict the attempted move of the weaker piece fails" which doesn't particularly mean anything - the game obviously needs a lot of work.

Scheisskopf Diplomacy II (Donald Wileman due to James Fenamore Whyte, Der Fliegende Hollander Vol 1 #6). Yet another unplayable hoax.

Dudland (Greg Costikyan with Scott Rosenberg, <u>Urf Durfal</u> #11). A rather atrocious variant, based on a rather atrocious press release series. The lists of double coasted provinces and four province points in the rules do not match the map, there is some confusion in the rules as to the rights of the "Custodian of the Dudness" with respect to dudded supply centers, and it is not made clear whether sea spaces or provinces on the other continent can be dudded, or whether armies can be dudded out to sea or fleets onto land. There are rules for government-in-exile and anti-dud units. One player (Teedeeay) may build one double army during the game, another (Californeiay) can send annual letters of attack which force a unit to hold. Needs work to make it worth playing. For those unfamiliar with the atrocious NY'ism "dud", any unit in a dudded province except those of the Custodian and anti-dud (or "dud-out") units is transported to a province of the Custodian's choice, though a "dud-out" unit unduds a dudded province. Definitely needs work.

dk. Slobbovia/Oct 1976 (proposed) revision (Ray Heuer for APA-Slobbovia). These are the rules of the game per se, or "Strumph". The rules of the APA, the "Slobstitution", which govern the rotating GM'ship, &c, are not included, but then the game does not require a rotating GM'ship. The rules of the press and protocols of the game, or "Strakh tradition", are not written down ever, which may prove annoying to new players since these govern the definition, power, and responsibilities of the Czar and the Holy Sativan Church. not to mention what is permitted to do in press and what military orders will bring everyone to war with you. Of course these do not necessarily carry over to other games. The rules do provide for a ruler/sub-ruler set up for units and provinces, purge rules, railroads, straits, mountains, deserts and sustain orders, and seizure of provinces instead of occupation, and to guarantee that no one wins, if a player doesn't leave 1 his provinces and units to sub-rulers (who can then secede) the gamemaster will have them revolt, one at a time. Players can enter the game at any time. The map and rules are both subject to amendment by vote of the players. In North America, Ray Heuer is serving as Arkhivist of APA-Globbovia; in Britain, Martley Patterson was running a similar game under the name "Carthage".
