

(The fact that a draw was proposed illegally in Cactus last season does not signify.) I would be interested to hear discussion of this HR, since the draw proposals might be another diplomatic tool for the players to use, even early in the game. Comments?

} PRESS--

CAIRO EXPRESS: Alarmed by the spread of "scientism", "republican government", and other "non-Christian ideals", the Tsar called today for an international conference to be held in Alexandria next month. Interrupting his prayer service at St. Sophia to make the announcement, the Tsar stated that the purpose of the conference would be to restore Europe to the rule of its rightful monarchs, lay the foundation for a "generation of peace", and reestablish the harmony lost by the collapse of the governments of the Germanspeaking peoples. ¶Russian officials confirmed today that the Tsar has a peace plan he intends to announce at the conference. The plan is said to involve triumvirate rule with England and Turkey to insure the good behavior of Europe's less stable countries. The Tsar has been in seclusion since last spring when all Europe reacted with disgust at French atrocities against civilians during the storming of Berlin. According to sources close to the Tsar, the French atrocities con-Sirmed what the Little Father believed all along: that the well-noted instability of republican ships of state without the firm hand of a monarch at the helm presents an ever-present danger to the future of Europe and must be eradicated. ¶Speaking from St.Petersburg, the monk Rasputin confirmed that the terms of the Russian peace proposal were revealed to the Tsar during his months of prayer at St. Sophia. Rasputin stressed that all European heads of state were expected to attend the conference and make their votes public.
"These choosing not to do so." said Rasputin. "can expect to face the wrath of God and the fury of the Russian people." ST.PETERSBURG PRESS: A paleological symposium, held last week in Paris, on the ancestry of the German-

spekaing peoples has drawn sharp criticism today from the Patriarch of Constantinople after a regularly scheduled meeting with the Tsar. Scientists at the week-long seminar sought to prove that the German-speaking peoples did not share the same genetic evolution as the rest of mankind and so were not, strictly speaking, Homo sapiens. Papers presented at the symposium argued that the Germanic peoples were actually descendants of a semi-intelligent strain of tree fungus, which explained their blatantly obvious inability to rule themselves. ¶Both the patriarch and Tsar condemned the symposium's conclusions as "contrary to Christian thinking" and an attempt "to excuse the rape and massacre of German civilians near Berlin." The Patriarch called the symposium "just one more example of the attempt of science to excuse bad human behavior." The Tsar called the Berlin massacre the "inevitable result of the mob rule known as republican government.
