## RESURGENCE OF THE GENERALS

## SINKING OF THE NAVY

All European Nations that we able to afford the raising of new forces chose to enhance their land forces this winter. On the other hand three of the four disbanded units were also army forces for a net change in the land sea ratio of only one unit. This is not expected to have any great advantages for the general staffs in their continuing battles with the admiralty.
