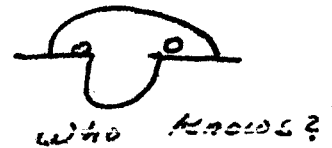

FRENCH CONTINUE PROPAGANDA OFFENSIVE    RUSSIANS REOCCUPY POLAND

TURKISH ARMY DISBANDED

Marsovia (MPC) Reports filtering into this capital as diplomats arrive for the Sixth Annual Marsovian News Association Invitational Bloodbath indicate that little change will occur in the next year. The recent Franco-Austrian war of words took a somewhat more solid form as the Austrian Ambassador was hit in the back of the head by a gigantic snowball. This in itself was not offensive, but the snowball exploded on impact. Russia and Turkey were observed in deep conferences apparently trying to form an anti-France alliance but negotiations were reported as stalled. What course the next year will bring in the war is a subject of much debate; the only general agreement is that the Austrian government will soon join Germany and Italy in the comfortable exile of the Marsovian capital.
