**FURIOUS WAR IN THE BALKANS: AUSTRIAN SWITCH RATHER THAN FIGHT**

**RUSSIANS MOVE SOUTH**

**FRENCH MOVE EAST**

Marsovia(MPC) The fine summer campaign weather produce a number of battles and sent the casualty figures soaring in the seventh year of the war. One entire Turkish Army was annihilated and the Russian defenders of St. Petersburg are said to have sufferend - and inflicted- heavy losses in their unsuccessful defense of the capital.
