Underlined moves do not succeed. The English F Por is dislodged and blown away. The Italian A War is dislodged and may retreat to Lvn, Pru, Sil, Gal, or the box. The Italian F Smy is dislodged and may run away to Eas, Syr, or the box. You will note that Andy Lischett has taken over Austria while Michael Lowrey has returned as Turkey; thanks to Steve Courtemanche for unused SB orders. The 1908 SC chart:

 TURKEY: ank, smy (2) BUILD ONE
