MUSIC AND RHYTHM: This was a compilation album put together as a benefit for a group called A World for Music, Arts, and Dance. It combines songs by David Byrne, Peter Gabriel, Peter Townsend, the English Beat, and XTC with the African folk songs which inspired or influenced them. This album makes quite a dramatic point, and it provides the listener with first rate entertainment at the same time.

THE MOODY BLUES, "In Search of the Lost Chord." I saw the Moodies in concert last week, so of course I was driven to pull out one or two of their old albums when I returned home. This one is the best of the bunch; it combines an orchestral sound with clever lyrics and a scattering of Indian sitar-meditation songs.
