Further notes about these special 5-man rules. Firstly, Germany and Italy are garrisoned with happy armies in all supply centers which have permanent HOLD orders, and which will not submit retreat orders, and which are consequently annihilated when they are dislodged.

The condition of victory is that the victorious Power have the majority of the units on the board.

The Brannan Rule on Convoys is to be followed: An attack by convoyed army is treated as if the attack came from the fleet last in the convoy-chain carrying the army. *and no convoyed support is allowed...*

An Army or fleet which might be attacking a province and be bounced out of that province by equal force and simultaneously ~~cannot~~ ~~may~~ be attacked by a unit such that a single unit (with legal support, as may occur) stands off two attacks made on it in two provinces in annihilated and both attacks on both provinces it was trying to defend succeed (as far as the defence factor of the unit in question is concerned, anyhow)
