...Recapened

Summer 1813: Several players apparently wish this game to continue. Bob Keathley has had a broken back and moved to a new job, and would much prefer to continue. Therefore, I will call for Fall 1813 moves. Charles Turner is requested to submit moves for Russia, his own country, and for England, in case Mike Childers does not respond. Current positions:

AUSTRIA (Bailey): A Vie, A Gal, A Bud, F Ven, A Tyr, A Gas.

ENGLAND (Childers): A Bre, A Bur, A Bel, F Wes, F NAf, F Mid, F Iri, F Eng.

RUSSIA (Turner): F Bot, F StP(so).

TURKEY (Keathley): F Ank, A Con, A Smy, F Por, F Aeg, A Sev, F Spa(so), A Mar, F Iro, F Gre, A Tri, A Rum, F Ion, A War, A Mos.

Note: Turkey owns 17 supply centers. He was unable to build 1 last Winter, and had one annihilated (A Ven, House Rule 12) in Spring 1813. Serbia is still unowned. FALL 1813 MOVES are due Thursday 23 April 1970.
