CHANGES IN THE HOUSE-RULES

1. Convoy Rule. Add Rule #36: CONVOY ORDERS. The movement order given to an army which is to be convoyed must specify the exact convoy route to be taken by the army, with the convoying fleets listed in the order in which the fleets will be used; thus: A Lon-Tun (Eng, Mid, Wes). Convoy orders given to fleets other than those listed are invalid, subject to the considerations of Rule 11.

2. Coastal Crawl. See NUMENOR 1009 for background of this. Delege House-Rules 21 and 22 entirely. House-Rule 21a is now HR 19, cotollary d. Add #37: SPACE. The word "space" in the Rules of Diplomacy is interpreted to mean "a province or body of water" (in the same way that "unit" means "army or fleet"). No ruling will be made, nor any movement allowed, which treats any province or body of water as if it were more than one space. No exchange of position (except as noted in House-Rule 19, cotollary d) will be allowed. The Coastal Crawl, the Crawling Retreat, and the Changing of the Guard are not used.
