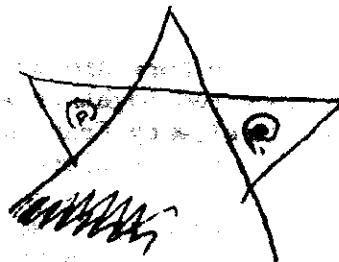
ENGLAND has LON, EDI, NWY, DEN, HOL, SWE, AND REIKINS CONSTANT

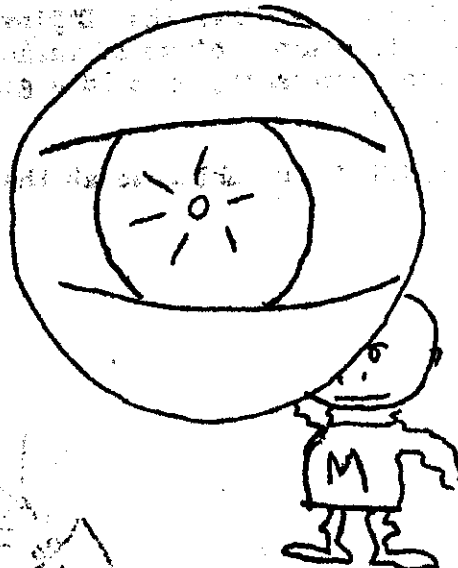
