AND NOW, WE HAVE "SWENSON'S RULE!! Those of us unfortunate enough to read "MISKATONIC UNIVERSITY" (more properly known as Swenson's Folly) have found therein a new rule even worse than Miller's infamous "Rule 9." PRESS RELEASES for 1966MB:

KONSTANTINOPOLIS (BBC): At his semi-annual press conference, held in the sumptuous "Fruit of Roissy" chamber of the Topkapi Seraglio, Pasha Hareem Al-Rashid announced extension of the Ottoman hand of friendship to the now-neighboring empire of Austria-Hungary. "In view of the evident political disorder surrounding the Hapsburg Throne," he remarked, "we have decided to include the Austro-Hungarians under our mantle of Collective Defense until such time as a rehabilitated Austria-Hungary can fully face on its own the menace of Devouring Democracy. We invite international participation in the renovation of the north Balkan empire according to the terms of the Black Sea Conference of 1797, the Trans-Caucasian Talks of 1799, and the Moscow-Konstantinopolis Agreement of 1801."

The Imperial Parliament, set to elect a Loyal Opposition after the coming Higeri Week Liberty Festival and Political Executions, voted unanimously to back the Pasha's proposal. A vote of acclamation was also accorded the emperor in regard to the controversial measure to adopt the defense program originated by Sky Ministry Grand Cyclops Dhermann von Ghuringh. Though harshly criticized as "not impossibly unwise" by Imperially Bedecked General Omar ibn Mountbatman of the famed Emerald Veil djinn special forces, the program has met with acclaim in most military quarters in spite of its call to extend the strategic air fleets at the expense of other conventional units.

Another innovation called for will add yet more effectiveness to the Imperial Sky Service, whose flying cappets with 2000-kilo Greek fire loads were so decisive in the Ottoman-victorious Turko-Melnibonéan War. A division of troops, to be dropped from transport rugs by Icarian wing in support of ground forces, is currently undergoing rigorous training to bring it up to Imperial fighting standards. The majority of this experimental unit has been taken from the Bear Creek Brigade of foreign mercenaries.

On the political scene, unrest continues over the coming elections. Informed sources indicate Achmed Peter Disraeli, well-known used-wife merchant and reputed power behind the Moonstone Throne, and Sheikh Djeorg Ztevens, possible Grand Kingfisher of the suppressed Mystic Knights of the Sea sect, have most support among the populace. Stories continue to spread, however, about the Pasha's twin brother, mysteriously abducted at birth and said to have been imprisoned in an iron fez for thirty-seven years at his brother's command. A corps of Hassanite Guardsmen from the Imperial Ministry of Public Information and Cultural Reform has been sent out to dispel the rumors.

LONDON AND MOSCOW: Jointly issued on the occasion of a state visit to London by His Imperious Majesty the Czar: The English and Russian governments issued a joint statement in celebration of the warm, fraternal relationships between their countries. His Majesty was received in London by hysterical throngs of Englishmen throwing roses, carnations, dahlias, and tomatoes in his path. His Majesty agreed to recognize English territorial rights in

Holland, Belgium, Picardy, and Brest. The English government recognized Russian sovereignty in Galicia, Bohemia, Tyrolia, and Vienna. The two governments expressed their profound desire for peace in Europe.

MOSCOW: During the absence of the czar, a brief revolt took place in Moscow, led by General Rebellnikoff. The return of the czar, proceeded by an army under the command of Gen. Ivan Kruscher led to the collapse of the rebellion. Among the documents captured was the text of a press release expressing conciliatory feelings toward the Holy Rolling Emperor. The czar took pains to deny the declaration of war attributed to Him by MISKATONIC UNIVERSITY and emphasized that his presence in Galicia had been a gesture of warning to Austria. However Austrian forces attacked the Russian armies in a cowardly felonious assault that represented a further extension of her aggressive policies towards Holy Mother Russia. This, in combination with obvious Austrian support of the Rebellnikoff revolution necessitates a declaration of a state of war between our countries. Russia is willing to accept peace based on recognition of Russian sovereignty in Bohemia, Galicia, Tyrolia, and Vienna, and the return of the revolting rebel Turhan Bey Pasha, who was reported to have fled to Budapest after his revolt collapsed. His Majesty concluded with an earnest prayer for peace.

LONDON: His excellency, Lord Kitchner-Battenmount Zilch, First Lord of the Admiralty, Second Lord of the Underdeveloped Airwing, states that "the sovereignty of the North Sea, the English Channel, the Irish Sea, the Mid-Atlantic, and the Western Mediterranean will be maintained. We will at any time offer assistance, succor Freudian casework principles, and Malatiasn ((?)) revolutionary practices to any indigenous population."

1966 AP PRESS RELEASES:

BRUXELLES: Upon the occasion of his triumphal entry into the Belgian capital, First Consul Napoléon Bonaparte declared his firm resolve to "Maintain order in all those European states not blessed by a firm and mature guiding hand or who yet rest under the iron hand of despotism." He expressed his concern over "the present state of anarchy existing in Italy."

PARIS: The foreign ministry today demanded that Austria recognize Turkish suzerainty over Greece.

VERSAILLES: The English ambassador and members of his staff were feted last night at a state banquet at which the Foreign Minister stated in a toast, "To the only two constitutional governments in Europe--may they live forever in peace."

PARIS: The foreign ministry today delivered a sharply worded note to the Russian government objecting in most strenuous terms to the "unwarranted, unprovoked Russian attack on German territory which can only be termed naked aggression."
