Paris-Moscow: Thanks for the news on Germany's intentions.

Italy-France: That a way, get Pudge before he has time to get his act together & lies to you!

Italy-Germany: Sorry, but Uncle Dan insisted on this opening! Yell at him!

Woody-Brown (either one): I don't know, I just think you two are somewhat less trustworthy than thieves.

MM. MACHIAVELLI POSTAL HOUSERULES

1. All Basic and Advanced rules will be used, plus Optional Rule III (Natural Disasters) and Optional Rule X (Money Lenders). The rules of MACHIAVELLI in the 1980 Avalon Hill edition will be followed, except where noted. Any Errata or Clarifications announced by Avalon Hill will be put in effect as soon as the GM learns of them.
2. The rules book pretty well covers the play of the game and illustrates the procedures for correct orders writing. Players are advised to use the notations for orders writing as given in the book as per the examples given.
3. All MURD'RING MINISTERS Houserules as published in MM#61 will be followed where applicable and if not superseded by any MACHIAVELLI Houserules.
4. Any order incorrectly written, given, etc. will be invalid but the expenditures for them will be taken nonetheless. All such orders will be treated as "HOLD" (H) orders.
5. Players should take their time and make sure their moves are all inclusive and correctly written. All phases, expenditures, build-ups, removals, etc., should be covered. DON'T leave it up to the GM to have to even begin to wonder what you intended.
6. You can either send your moves in on the original MACHIAVELLI sheet in which case the GM will return it to you along with the zine carrying the results. Or you can submit your moves on regular paper, but if you do, you should follow the same format as on the MACHIAVELLI sheet.
7. Players are urged to use the same abbreviations for names of provinces, seas, etc., as is explained in Rule VII.A.2.

8. SEQUENCE OF PLAY: There will be an automatic separation of moves for the Military Unit Adjustment and Income Phase. Thus, a complete year campaign will take four months:
 First Month-Military Unit Adjustment and Income Phase and Announcement of Famine Results.
 Second Month-Spring Campaign.
 Third Month-Summer Campaign.
 Fourth Month-Fall Campaign and Next Year's Income Announcement.
 ((NOTE: Famine Relief can only be accomplished in the Spring Campaign orders.))
9. DEADLINES: A four-week deadline schedule will be followed with moves and results in each monthly issue of MM.
10. EXTENSIONS: Will be granted upon request if ALL players agree.
11. VICTORY CONDITIONS: Rule II, C (Advanced Victory Conditions)
12. NMRs: If a player NMRs, his move will be handled as if an assassination had occurred, Advanced Rule VI.B.6.; that is, all units will receive automatic "Hold" orders; NMRs for the adjustment and income phase will have the effect of maintaining all existing units to the extent that the income allows.
13. SCENARIO: THE BALANCE OF POWER 1454 - all eight powers will be assigned.
14. DROPOUTS: If a player NMRs twice consecutively, he will forfeit the position to a Standby Player if any are available. If there are none, the player who drops will have his units all become Autonomous Garrisons.
15. Comments are welcome.
16. All die rolls will be done by the GM or his son Corey.

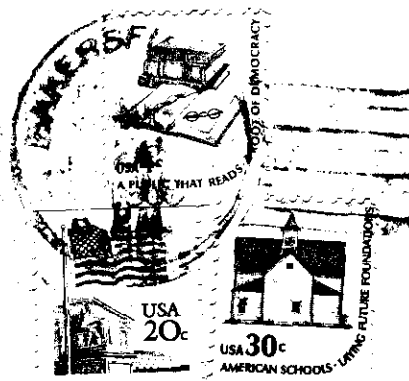
