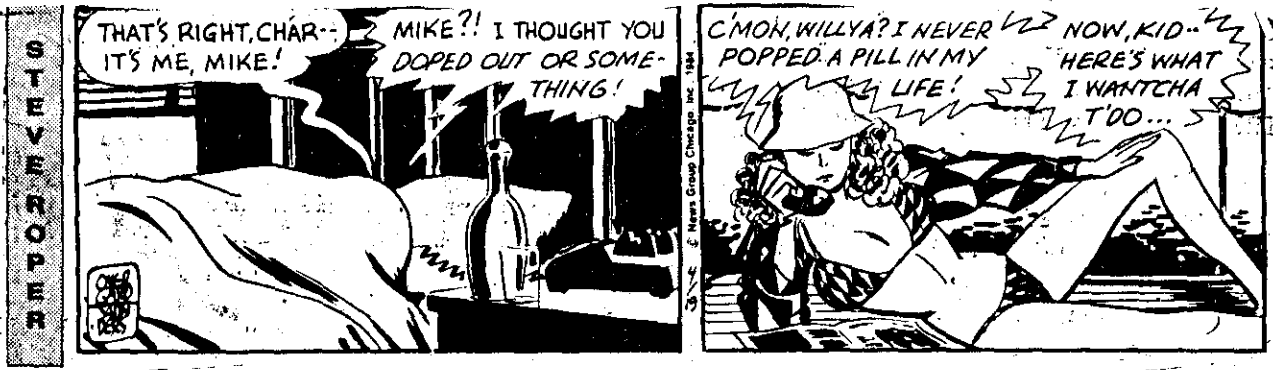

THE 1984 NIXON AWARD

I'm sorry that it has taken $\frac{1}{2}$ of this year to get around to releasing the latest winner of the NIXON AWARD. That facile pen that produced such sparkling and witty "Golden Age" press? Who would have dreamt that it could be turned to such an incidious purpose. And now look.. Brux lies before you, a battered wreck, and Oaklyn has been reduced to having to reenter the hobby under the pathetic guise of Ken Peel.

And, alas, consider me. A once promising, bright-eyed novice who thought he might be able to have some fun and, hey, perhaps even win a game once in awhile. Five years ago, five years ago, I played my first game of postal DIP with Bob Olsen. We were allies. Well, I was young and impetuous . . . I, you might say, extended the truth a bit. Oh all right, I stabbed him. I was young, foolish. I have never been the same. Soon thereafter, Bob submitted me for the NIXON Award and his entry won (thanks a lot, Ron!), thereby ensuring that I would never be successful in a DIP game again. But was that enough for this venomous viper? Noooo . . .

Bob has never GM'd a game before. But after five year of planning and laying the groundwork, of careful manipulation, he invites me into a game with the other three NIXON Award winners (the deserving ones) which he is GMing. Sure, I say, eager to make peace. He gleefully assigns me Germany between "Liar Al" Pearson, and "Scumbag" Aranawoodian who, as the hobby well knows, always ally. As Italy, he has his beloved Baglady who has 93 postal wins, all as Italy. As Russia, there is Ken Peel, (Oaklyn

A bit more on the future of MM . . . Sorry, gang. I am finding that it is just impossible to meet my goal of publishing one regular monthly issue with all the games included for all to enjoy. Increased demands in other areas of life's responsibilities are preventing me from spending as much time as it is necessary to publish MM in the same way it has been since Oct. of 1978. When I started, I was single and I had an enormous amount of time to devote to hobby stuff. But then came a wife, a child, then another child and things have just gotten to the point where I cannot do it any more. Therefore, with a heavy heart, I have decided to fold MM. Here's how I'd like to be allowed to do it:

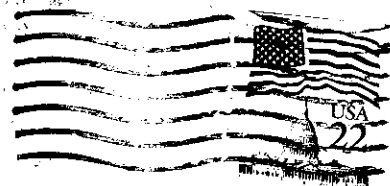
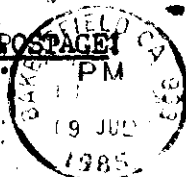
