This is MONGCO, the oldest bulletin of postal Diplomacy in existence. It carries the new game starting below. MONGO is a Grendel Press publication edited by Conrad von Metzke, 1530 $\frac{1}{2}$ Dale Street, San Diego, California 92102. It is an integral sub-'zine of COSTAGUANA.

Players and subscribers will be treated to a survey of the past history of postal Diplomacy's very first magazine as this game goes along. MONGCO was originally begun in 1962 when your humble editor was 18 years old. It was printed on the ditto machine at San Diego State College, Social Sciences Division, for free (I stole paper). It was typed on the selfsame typewriter I still use, my 1933 Underwood that my father bought for \$6. at a junk store in Los Angeles in 1954. (When present issue is using a different typewriter because I'm away from home for two weeks.) The first postal Dipoy game ever, which we might call 1962-A (although it was not numbered as such until eight years later) was never finished; lack of player interest, plus a miniscule field of players to draw from (we only knew about eight in those days), caused the game to be abandoned. The magazine folded with the game, and the present revival is the first since then.

As we go, MONGCO will be fully traced and documented herein. I will even make available reproductions of the original issues (which were only just barely classifiable as 'magazines') for the sake of historical preservation.

Fie on John Boardman! His magazine has lost its last remaining point of interest; as the second oldest bulletin of postal Diplomacy it languishes in obscurity.

The next COSTA, which will reach you well before the deadline, will contain the new Broadel Press House-Rules. (Like visiting young ladies who happen to be otherwise taken; or other little stuffs....)

No offense is intended, ma'am. I'm teasing.

Enough. Press releases are invited with your moves. DO NOT FORGET THE DEADLINE; my policy is to drop players immediately from the game if they miss for Spring 1901, so don't fall prey. And read those house-rules when you get 'em, and don't be afraid to ask if they confuse or disturb you.

ST PETERSBURG (Jan. 22, 1901): Visits by the German and French Ambassadors were cordial and correct. However, Mr. Hein's minor indiscretion of getting his hand caught in Miss Kaignath's back was rather unforgivable. The court of the Tsar had never seen a puppet in a strapless evening gown - it was a first.

MOSCOW - Century Day 1910. Rejoicing throughout the world lauded the accomplishments of Lendery Beekovka on this, the sixtieth anniversary of the new treaties of prosperity. It was Comrade Beekovka who, the world shall remember, prevented World War IV in 2000 after finally signing the demilitarization zone treaties with Canada and Israel. Through these treaties stellar colonization could again resume after the eight-year pause between tri-focal induction to Alpha Centauri 4.1c (see COMA this issue for more on Tri-Focal Induction.) Finally the shattered nations in South, Central, and Western North America could reconstruct the damaged wreckage of the Sino-U.S. war. Finally the peoples of eastern Europe from the hold of the big three could rejoice. Finally the nations of the Indo-African nuclear race were scrubbed up. It was a year to rejoice - at last peace was a reality in this war-torn world. Development and breeding of the Americas, Africa, and Eastern Asia must now catch up to the levels of the automated world.

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Within twenty years, it was hoped, the fertile lands would again be usable, and the elimination of the 'unachieving' classes of reproducers would be fact. It was in this year our story begins - the story of Earth's contact with the fantasy-world of Beta-Criton 7.

MOSCOW - Century Day - 2100

Technological Development Calendar - Annotated

- 1983 - Nuclear Impulse Engine - Berkeley-Velocity attained in testing 89,000 ft/sec.
- 1984 - Magnesium-Silicon 7 introduced. Tensile strength approx. 27,000 lb/in², hardness (OIA) 7.54. S.G. .9441
- 1981 - Anti-matter converter created - Berlin.
- (1992) - Explosive destruction of AMG 1, wiping out most of East Germany.
- 1997 - Tripartate motive laws explained (Jerusalem). Thus travel became a tri-dimensional functionality - energy-space, time, matter conversion. The law of tripartate motion stated that only twodimensional could co-exist for the same unit of mass, i.e. time-energy, time-space, energy-matter, space-matter, time-matter.
- 2004 - Matter conversion accomplished - Vancouver.
- 2008 - Matter conversion beam created - Toronto.
- (2011) - Indo-African race wars begin with Indian 8th Fleet landing on the east coast of Africa.
- (2012) - Sino-American War begins. The Sino-American conflict was a direct result of foolish alliances maintained by China with Egypt and the U.S. with India. Long range nuclear exchanges between the powers produced destruction far beyond the reach of any imagination. Only the American Mid-West and Canada were protected by matter conversion lasers. The use of AMG bombs by the U.S. in 2016 wiped out the south-east coast of China, while the erratic missiles of China destroyed the U.S. west and much of Mexico.
- 2024 - Trifocal induction coupled with matter conversion - Jerusalem.
- 2025 - TIMC also reproduced in Toronto on a far smaller scale.
- 2027 - MID motive power finally leashed to a MS7 capsule - in Russia's Nekone 4 - which orbited Neptune for three months before return to Earth.

- 2031 - Breeding of Russian populace along the Bastilov Theory introduced. Basically - using 20th Century notation - only IQs of 125 or higher are retained, as well as dexterity quotients of 1.8 and heredity imperfection factors of .95 or higher.
- (2044) - Big Three thereby limits the use of AMG devices and places backward Western Europe under direct control of the member nations, Israel, Canada, and Russia.
- (2051) - Reconquista of Eastern Africa and Western U.S. begins.
- 2053 - Decontamination of AMG antimatter finally achieved in China and India.

TEMC's convert matter to antimatter (sans mass), then through the interface (sans time). Yet the triangular base for inductions must be sufficiently large. 4. Equus: A noble and adaptive beast. Friend and foe to the Humeroids, as befit their station.

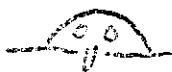
Monsters:
