(BUDAPEST)- Led by regent Kirk von Winston Salem, the Austro-Hungarian government formally retook control of Vienna today. Flanked by representatives of the allies of Austria-Hungary, Germany, France, and Italy, Winston-Salem led a procession into the central square of the city, where he gave a short address. With tears in his eyes, the Regent thanked Austria's allies for the Aid they provided, and stated, that since all Austrian territory was back under government control, an imperial diet would be held in the next few months for the purpose of designating a successor to Franz Josef II.

Von Winston-Salem concluded his address with the following remarks: "The forces of righteousness are on the march; they will not be stopped. Comrade Hagelshawski will be made to pay for the crimes against the people of his own land, as well as those he has occupied. Let us pray ~~xxxxxx~~ that next year at this time we will be meeting with our allies in Moscow as we put Hagelshawski and his cohorts on trial. In conclusion, let me warn those who have chosen to ally themselves with the comrade that they too will pay for what they have done.

into the Ionian Sea touched off the rioting, gratingly commented on the high proportion of snipers and marksmen in the mob and reaffirmed his decision. "The lack of discipline in Task Force Gamma could not have been more clearly demonstrated. The patriotic fervor of the recruits cannot be doubted, but until their ardor for revenge upon the Turk is tempered by a willingness to unquestioningly obey orders they cannot and will not be entrusted with the crucial spearhead role."

(Paris) George McGovern uncovered a secret government report on Sept. 1st which stunned the nation and embarrassed Pres. Pompos Doo. The report, entitled "The Hexagon Papers", reveal that George C. Floorace was sent to Rome to uncover the source of Italian pornography which has been pouring into southern France and the Iberian states illegally during the past two years. According to the report, Floorace found that it was Italian merchant ships which were carrying the immoral cargo and that he urged Pres. Pompos Doo to finance pirates to destroy the Italian ships. The President took Floorace's advice and subsidized the pirate raids on the Italian merchant ships. Floorace also found the source of the pornography, the Italian naval installations in Naples. He photographed the installations but had to leave the pictures behind in his quick escape from that country. The report concluded in announcing that Floorace was back in France, residing in the palace of Versailles. It is now believed that actual naval units of Italy are attempting to land the pornography in southern France. French units are being sent south to see to it that the pictures do not land. Although France does not want a conflict with Italy, Pres. Pompos Doo believes that the Italians will invent some propoganda to legitimize a war. (Rome) Wishing to avoid war with France, the Italian Government has reversed its earlier stand on the issue of Spain. The official spokesman, Dr. U. Betchinni, said "If France does not make any warlike moves during the remainder of 1902 the army now in the Piedmont will not invade France. If Italian security is threatened in any way the necessary steps will be taken to safeguard it."

(VIENNA)--(Aug)-- It was announced by the Austrian General Staff that due to the overwhelming and UNEXPECTED complete rout of all Russian military units, the State of Austria-Hungary now enjoys complete national security and integrity.

The Staff spokesman was questioned as to probable Austrian military intentions now that "Russia is crippled", he responded by saying, "The situation is as follows; to the west, Austria's General Staff now trusts Italy completely and absolutely, enjoys good diplomatic relations with W England, is concerned with the weakness of Germany, and finally, as far as France goes, we have yet to receive a reply from France to a letter we sent on MARCH 19th, 1972, one might say Austria enjoys better relations with Russia than France (LAUGHTER)".

The spokesman added: "We are so concerned with the deteriorating situation in Germany that we are seriously considering sending an Austrian Army to Tyrolia to defend not only Austria but Italy as well, against the French hordes," therefore the spokesman said, "our present and future policy to the West consists of very close, cooperative relations with the state of ITALY, Austria & Italy have somehow managed to demilitarize their common borders at least to some extent,--quite an accomplishment, and I might add, to the benefit of both countries. There is no better proof of warm Austro-Italian relations than the present situation: Italy is moving its military units East & South !!!".

What about the East? the spokesman was asked, "To the East our relations with Russia are rather obvious (laughter), however I do not think Austria need fear or ask favors of Russia at this point (laughter), as to Turkey, I should like to inform you that the Austrian General Staff has been approached by Turkey with the request of a detente, the Austrian General Staff has yet to determine whether continuing the present policy of moving against both Russia and Turkey should be better than trusting the Turks and moving all military units against Russia to gain her valuable supply centers, leaving the southern front in a passive position. In other words, we are not sure of Turkey's sincerity just yet."

(Berlin) The Kaiser came out of the Berlin Schluss today. Upon hearing that the fleet had entered Belgium successfully, he said, "If ~~this~~ this fleet cannot get to the High seas we will have to supervise the building of one that can ourselves." Arrangements are complete for the Kaiser to visit the naval base at Kiel in early October.

(Rome)- The Darende Department announces the transfer of Prof. Seymour C. Battles of the Italian Naval Academy at Cranappolis where beach-strolling sailors see the ocean spray to the fleet in Tunis.

(Venice)- Venetian Police stunned by the bloody rash murders which have plagued the city since fall found ten victims in the canals today. The total of deaths in the current madness is 521 dead. Venice remains terrified and rumors run rampant, yet no official has offered an explanation for the most heinous crimes in the history of Venice.

(Rome)- President Charvoz-Aristo in a shocking disclosure showed proof that Austrian Millionaire J. Howard von Hapsburg financed the abortive attempt to assassinate President Charvoz-Aristo last March. Also, the President disclosed that the Austro-Hungarian government is secretly aiding the legalized abortion drive in Italy in order to limit the population of Italy as a captured war document explained. The document went on to say that Austria plans war with Italy in the distant future and wants as few men around to fight the planned aggression. Italy has filed an official protest to the Austro-Hungarian embassy. However, the President refuses to declare war despite public opinion favoring declaring war. (Rome)- BULLETIN - The Senate declared war on Austria-Hungary moments ago. Pres. Charvoz-Aristo in a stirring speech to the people of the world had asked for the declaration after shocking his audience with proof obtained by Swiss Inspector Sir Loim showing that Aus-Hun trained a band of vampires whose slogan was "Vienna Blood March" to attack Venetian citizens. Sir Loim expressed his thoughts by saying, "Italy has a stake in Europe and will not be intimidated by greedy Imperial Majesties."
