(Berlin) - Whereas the incorrect printing of the move F Den-Swe P01 placed Germany in an impossible diplomatic position which would not otherwise have resulted (according to the testimony of the Russian player), and whereas Germany's attempts to defend itself long enough for that condition to change were negated by Nielsen's refusal to use SO2 moves admittedly received by the gamemaster (albeit by Marsland, but at ~~that~~ a time when he was still the GM, --it being thus solely a game-managerial error that the moves were not forwarded, the correction of which remained Nielsen's responsibility) and the incompetent and incomplete use of sealed orders, it becomes impossible for me to accept responsibility for the resultant position. In plain language, I am resigning in protest of massive and prejudicial game-mismanagement.

(Berlin)- What happened to the Russo-German non-aggression pact?
(Genoa)- The Round Pastry Co. announced today that "a square pie" has been developed by Sir Kull, descendant of Arthurian knight Sir Conference, Mr. Ray DiUaso, descendant of Ark M. Edies and Ferd Diameturre and G. M. Stree, son to a former Greek ruler and seller of 100 proof alcohol. The price of the pastry will be in the area of \$3.14/dozen.
