Press:

(Rome) It was officially announced today that Italy has been protected from any possible French aggression. Similar deals are being worked upon, the announcement continued, but Austria and Turkey show little inclination to reach negotiated settlements.

(Naples) Several warehouses burst into flames today, the victims of a mysterious arsonist. Lech Inc. is asking for 4,000,000 Lira to make good its losses of "high grade printed material". It is rumored that the arsonist was working under direct orders from the government.

(Venice) The city prepared for the imminent Austrian occupation. Refugees are streaming along the roads to the west. The water supply has been prepared for destruction. Citizens defence groups are being organized to barricade city streets and block the boatways. Those who remain are quiet, grim and purposeful-the panic-stricken have left the city, and their vanguard has reached the Italian flying columns being rushed to the area. It is hoped that France will respect the new treaty, and not take advantage of an undefended border.

(Rome)- Here are highlights of Pres. Charvos-Aristo's first television interview with Blue House Correspondent, Dan Gather:

Gather: Reports persist that Italian troops have killed innocent women and children in the drive to take Vienna. Are these true? What steps have you taken to prevent these murders- if the reports are true.

The President: Unfortunately, there have been a couple cases of civilians being killed. Those responsible will be tried according to military law. I also have issued specific instructions for field commanders to follow in order to prevent these type of incidents. It is not our policy to kill innocent peoples. We avoid all shelling of military targets in places where there is any realistic chance that innocents will become victims.

Gather: What is your personal reaction to the bakery announcement of last Fall?

The President: WE will not desert our friends.
