Furthermore, as a consequence, France would have to decide to leave her entire homeland defenseless. These same Austrian officials suggested that perhaps France should think twice before committing herself to a "laborious" war; in the east, especially as England is day-by-day growing more powerfully Besides, said one source, the Austrian Government has a no a "bone to pick" with France.
