Weidmark as Russia illegally retreated P Sweden to the Baltic - the attack which dislodged it came from that province. Therefore I contacted the players involved, and informed Weidmark that his P Sweden had been illegally retreated and therefore he could not have taken Kiel: This meant Germany got a build and Russia had to remove a unit. This issue the Winter turns for 1972Q and 1972BI are done.

PARIS - The French Office of Foreign Affairs has acknowledged the reception of two Austrian dispatches whose moods were described as "cordial." The second dispatch in part examines the current alliance structure and supplies suggestions "In the case of a change in the structure." President Pomouos Duc immediately cited the dispatch as evidence of "Austria is in complete trust of Turkey, a trust so unlike that between France and England."
