ATHENS (ENS) Albania has changed its earlier stand on the Turkish request for permission to enter the country. Earlier reports had indicated a hard line, but all talk of a confrontation evaporated with the announcement that the Albanian monarch had accepted the invitation to visit Constantinople. A lightning tour has already started. The Albanian King, Gherous the Great, is a lover of art, so several hours will be spent admiring the beautiful artwork in the harem. No further details on the King's visit to Turkey are available. Queen Besa has been left home in Albania, to assure "continued tranquility on the home front."

COMRADE HAGELSHAWSKI RE-ELECTED AS PREMIER

When the final results of the March elections were tabulated it was found that Comrade Hagelshawski is the people's choice for Premier. Everywhere in Russia evidence can be found of the strong support that exists for the Premier's war and domestic policies. Many experts had previously stated that Hagelshawski was the man to lead the Russian people forward to victory against the Austrian and English imperialist aggressors.

The final vote was: Hagelshawski 73,996,100 (People's party), I.M.A. Dumasky (Czarist party) 521, for a total of about 74,000,000 votes. When it was pointed out that the voting population of Russia is only 40,000,000, a government agent replied, "Well, we always encourage a strong voter turnout." Dumasky was not available for comment.
