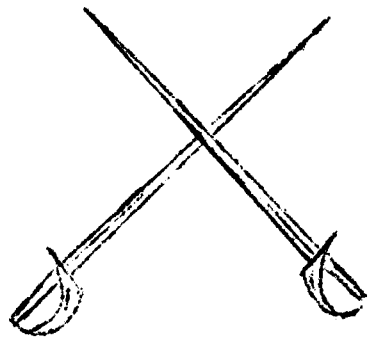
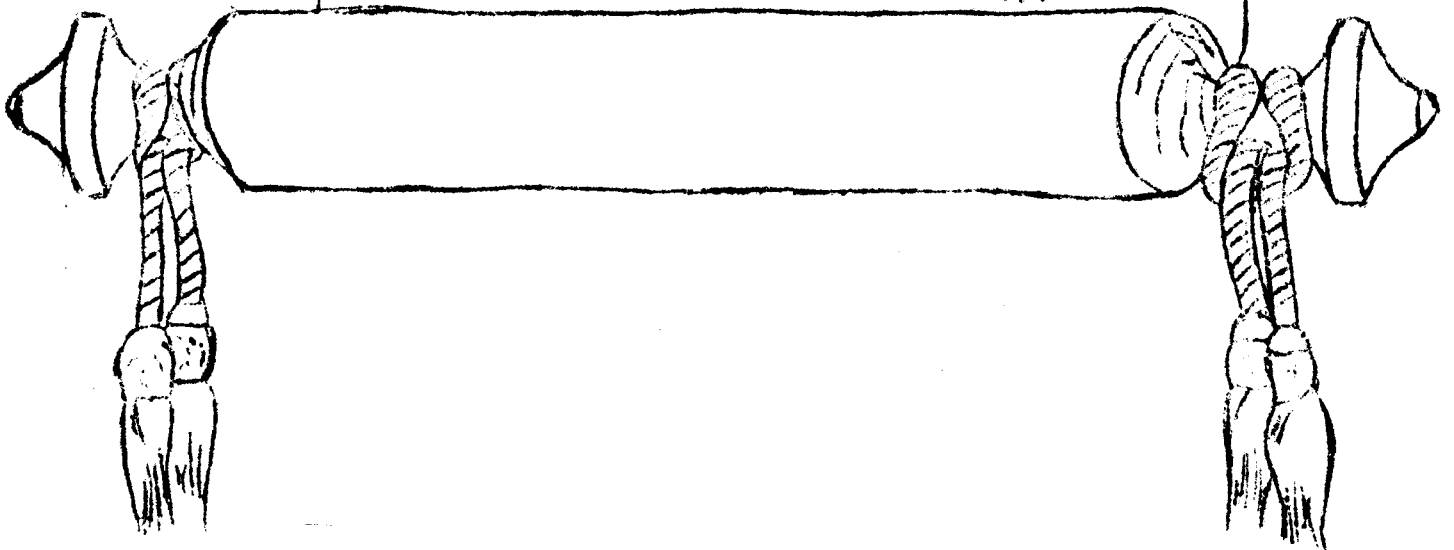


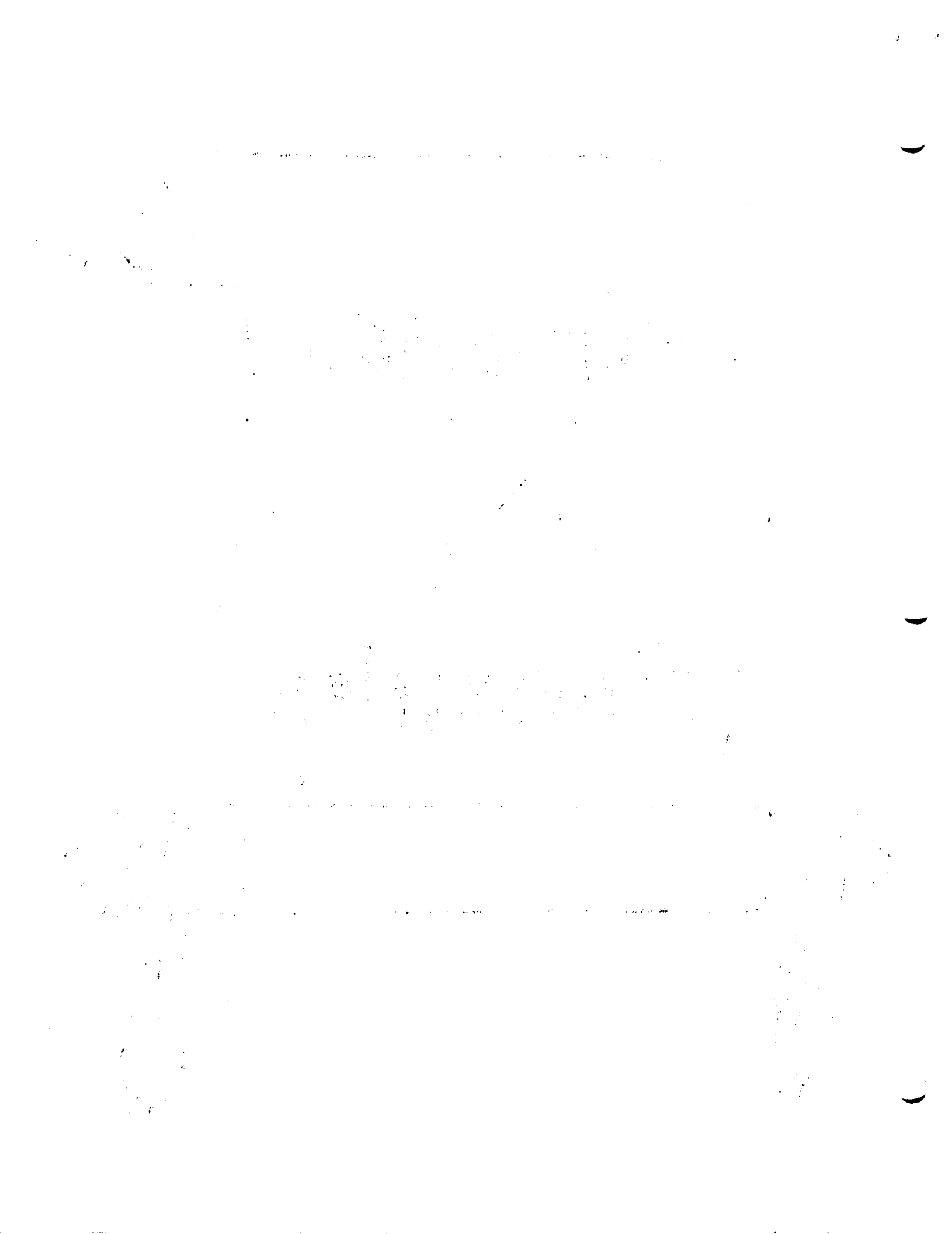

Press Releases:

Galicia (Nov. 1) Ian Schink, governor of the people of Galicia, expresses the deep regret of all Galicians at the departure of the great Imperial Austro-Hungarian Army. Congratulations to General and Mrs Henry von Krautenberg on the birth of a baby, Kraut.

SERBIA (Oct. 21): Great preparations that have been going on in our fair state this past year are nearing completions, A hearty welcome is extended to the influx of new Austro-Hungarian Serbs.

VIENNA(December): "Silent night, Holy Night....."

VIENNA: The Dual Monarchy of Austro-Hungary wishes that all countries interested in learning to waltz in the world's best fashion to COME post haste to Vienna, the world's most cultured city.

LONDON: The kingdom of England is grieved at the death of Her Royal Majesty Queen Victoria and would like to invite the heads of state of all European states to her funeral. The date of this event will be decided later.

The foreign minister of England is appalled with all the current aggression in Europe especially since France and England are trying desperately to preserve peace in Europe by encouraging such peaceful events as the Olympic Games held a year ago in Paris.

NEMEDIAN CHRONICLES

This column will be used to describe some of the assets and defects of the various countries on the playing board. Next time, I will begin describing each country's ~~own~~ general strategy in detail.

The countries on the board can be divided into three general classes according to relative power.

Group I: includes England and Turkey. These countries are on the edge of the playing board, fairly easy to defend, and provide the attacker with no immediate gain.

Group II: consists of France, Italy, and Russia. These countries are more or less in the thick of the matter, but have quite a variety of choice in their course of action, and can more or less decide what to do.

Group III: is made up of Germany and Austria, generally considered to be the two weakest powers on the board. These countries are usually the first subjects of hostile action on the board because of their central location, their wealth of supply centers, and their difficult-to-defend positions. These countries have to be very careful in their diplomacy, and should not go out of their way to antagonize their neighbours. The consolation is that they are interesting to play, and if they can overcome their initial difficulties, they can quite often make something of the game. ((jrnz))
