The countries on the board can be divided into three pereral classes according to relative power.

Croup I: includes England and Turkey. These countries are on the edge of the playing board, fairly easy to defend, and provide the attacker with no immediate gain.

Group II: consists of France, Italy, and Russia. These countries are more or less in the thick of the matter, but have quite a varity of choice in their course of action, and can more or less decide what to do.

Group III: is made up of Germany and Austria, menerally considered to be the two weakest powers on the board. These countries are usually the first subjects of hostile action on the board because of their central location, their wealth of surely centers, and their cit idult-to-defend positions. These countries have to every careful in their diplomacy, and should not go out of their way to antagonize their neighbours. The consolation is that they are interesting to play, and if the can overcome their initial direculties, they can guite often make something of the game. ((jrnz))
