Okay, I'm sitting here with a selectric handy so I might as well put the Navy's time to good use. Jack got into London and he supported the wop into Munich in 1901. Meanwhile the east was a mess. We strggled in the west until suddenly a rather ominous R-T stood across the middle of the board. Jack broke all of his own most dearly held theories and decided to play for a draw rather than the win.

Jack and Ed went away and we played a second game with roughly the same resuslts. This time we had a four-way instead of a five way but my England controlled Scandinavia, Germany and was on the verge of blitzing through Russia, I had <u>lots</u> of armies.

So there's some typing for those of you who bitch and moan about my lettering. Take it away Ed.

An FTF, a Draw and Lessons Learned: Confession of a Rookie

Random assignment: Italy, Groan. Actually, the afternoon started well. I arrived -- ten minutes late -- only to discover that four of the participants were still missing (one accounted for, three whereabouts unknown). A short while later the

participants were still missing (one accounted for, three whereabouts unknown). A short while later the others appeared, and we got underway with surprisingly little wasted time.

This was to be my first FTF (and first complete game, although I was not fated to survive) in something over ten years, so I was eagerly looking forward to it. It was also my first meeting with two of my pubbers (Tallman and Meinel) as well as with several other (in)famous persons who shall remain nameless herein. Tallman, by the way, can't possible be more than six-four, and for some reason he disguises his blond hair... The game. FTF differs from postal Diplomacy in several respects. For instance, it is almost impossible to achieve a successful stab after the first few turns, as it is entirely too easy for everyone else to see who you are talking to and for how long. In addition, simple-minded people like me need a little more time to think over the available options and then to discuss them with everyone. I also thought a disproportionate amount of time was spent discussing the formation of the stalemate lines among members of the obvious RT and EFG alliances. This particular game ended in a five-way draw: I would have been surprised to see that result had it been played by mail.

It all began harmlessly enough. R/T versus Austria and a misguided Italy in the east with England, France and Germany jockeying for position in the west. My Italians and the French did manage to slow German expansion by forcing them to defend Munich the first year, thereby gaining just one build; but the French

My Italians and the French did manage to slow German expansion by forcing them to defend Munich the first year, thereby gaining just one build; but the French stab of England in London, which occurred at the same time, prevented any follow-up effort against the Germans. France and England were at odds for years following the stab, while Germany played catch-up and I sent a fleet to the Mid-Atlantic looking for something to do. I also sent an army all the way to Silesia for the same reason. My buddy, Austria, felt he could do without help, and soon built up a force of seven units--the first power in the game to reach that lofty plateau. Unfortunately, the Austrian and I couldn't work up a coordinated plan, so I finally gave up and stabbed him in Trieste at the same time R/T started a well-coordinated effort to cut him up in the lower Balkans. Hmmm--bad timing. Also during this time period Italy had a fleet in the Eastern Med which didn't have anything in particular to do--lack of proper prior planning strikes again.

Moving right along, EFG finally got together after some more juggling and decided to move east en masse about the time Austria expired and I was in the process of losing Trieste and then Venice to a continuance of the coordinated R/T attack. Something could probably have been salvaged at this point if any sort of Italian-German communication had existed: unfortunately it had ceased shortly after the end of 1901, and by this stage of the game the German was being monopolized by the E/F while I was being badgered by R/T. The German was doubtless a bit annoyed with me anyway: I wouldn't leave Munich alone. I took it once, too--

during the Spring. Ugh.

At any rate, the West was about a year too far away to help Italy and I decided to be as annoying as possible to R/T on my way out. A basically futile gesture, as I was steam-rollered anyway, and out by the end of 1908.

Then the stalemate lines were drawn--through Italy ("sniff"), along the German border, and around St. Petersburg. The final result was interesting to me bacause the subject of a draw had come up several times starting at about four o'clock (sometime in '05 or '06, I think it was). The desultory play continued for another two-and-a-half hours before a draw was finally agreed upon.

One suggestion which could help avoid a draw like the one which occurred in this case is to require every surviving player to spend five minutes with each other survivor in a separate room--a process which might require twenty minutes or so. In this particular game the Turk might have had a chance by going it alone: he built several unnessary fleets near the end of the game. A couple of armies moving on the totally undefended Russian centers in the Balkans, perhaps coupled with a French move against the English, and it could have been a different game. Ahhh...what do I know, anyway?

It was fun, and with luck I'll get to do it again. Next time, there will be some changes made...


