
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THE OZ FREE PRESS is a production of Pandemonium Publications, edited and published by Capt. Rod Walker, 1575-A White Dr., Rantoul, Ill. 61866. TOFP chronicles the progress of Das Dippyspiel (or Imperialism XII), the game that gives you nightmares. Active and stand-by status are by invitation only. The game fee is \$1 for each three issues (see A Modest Proposal, below). Das Dippyspiel uses the Rules of Diplomacy, as amended by the Dippyspiel Rules and interpreted by the EREHWON House-Rules. Sets of maps are 50¢; back issues are 25¢. The Editor places no limit on the amount of press releases, poetry, pictures, dialogue, and other stuff you submit; however, should this cause the issue to go over 20 pages in length, he reserves the right to charge \$1 (or fraction), for publication of material above the first 3/4 page of press releases, per page (or fraction). No charge will be made for original art work. Under no circumstances will the Editor publish material which, in his opinion, is protected by copyright or which lack sufficient originality to merit publication; save that the John R. Weill illustrations from the original Oz stories will be occasionally reproduced, in keeping with the name of this zine. All submissions are subject to editing. Non-players may submit propaganda, but will be charged the fee of \$1 per page (or fraction) for each such submission. Any resemblance between persons and places mentioned in this 'zine and any real persons and places you know of will be reported to the Narcotics Distision of the F.B.I.

#### A MODEST PROPOSAL

You know, publishing the silly financial statement is more trouble than it's worth. For one thing, it takes up 1/2 a page or more, which could be used for your valuable press releases. Also, I think we could make money by revamping the fee scheduling. I believe that the 'zine is going to stabilize at about 20 pages (your Editor and his Magic Blue Pencil will make sure of that). Assuming, then, a run of 50 copies and 20 pages, plus (currently) 28 active players plus stand-by players, we may assume \$3 for masters, \$3.60 for postage, \$2 for paper (one ream), and \$1.00 for ink and other stuff, a total expenditure of \$9.60 for one issue. That's \$28.80 for three issues, or only 80¢ more than I take in. Therefore, if there is no objection, I propose this: we run the 'zine on a fee of \$1 for 3 issues. Subscription fees will be used to defray postage to subbers, add extra pages at no additional cost to the players, publish special supplements (like our flag supplement), and like that. If an issue runs significantly under 20 pages, I will note any fee adjustments which will be made. Judging from the volume of press releases and other stuff, I doubt that will happen.

## PAPAL ELECTION

Counting the votes cast (and several countries cast none at all), the candidates of the following countries received votes as follows: PODERKAG, 80; C.S.A., 27; MISKATONIA, 20; FRENCIANA, 11; HYDUNDERBAD, 11; EFGIART, 10; MARSOVIA, 10; KALMAR, 8. Only Poderkagg received over 31 votes and received enough to create 2 Papal supply centers. In accordance with Rule 5, as revised (see below), Poderkagg may name an Interim, or Minority, Pope. A new Papal Election for the year 1502 is automatically called for.

### THE RULES : CHANGES AND ADDITIONS

#### Changes:

Rule 5. Add, as a final paragraph: "In the absence of a properly elected Pope, the country receiving the largest number of votes at any Papal Election may proclaim an Interim, or Minority, Pope. This will provide the least discontinuity in the Papal succession. The name assigned to each Pope (real Pope or Minority Pope) must be in consonance with Church history published to date in The Oz Free Press. Popes given a name already assigned to a preceding Pope use the next succeeding number to designate order of accession. Popes given other names may use a number (that is, be numbered II or higher), but the responsible player must provide dated predecessors (and histories, if possible) to account for the number assigned. Such predecessors must fit into Church History as already published and will then constitute official additions to Church History.

If the player whose country currently holds the Papacy resigns or is dropped from the game, his Pope will be declared "dead" and a new election held. The player holding the Papacy may also declare his Pope "dead", thus precipitating a new election.

- Rule 8. Change the first sentence to read, "Pollutidar can win by accumulating control of 51% of the world's gold holdings at the end of a Winter move." The next-to-last sentence should read: "Each mine produces 100G annually."
- Rule 19. Delete from the first paragraph the sentence reading, "Every sabotage order issued...whichever is smaller." Insert: "The SIC may win the game by accumulating control of 51% of the world's gold holdings at the end of a Winter move."

#### New Rules:

- 20. The planet Vulcan will be a pseudo-player. He will have the power of support and transfer. Vulcan will have 10 space-fleets in the visinity of Earth. On any turn, each space-fleet may (1) support the move of any unit, (2) transfer any amount of gold from one province to one other province, or (3) convoy any army or cavalry from one province to one other province. Vulcan can win the game by accumulating control of 51% of the world's gold holdings at the end of a Winter move.
- 21. With Pollutidar's expressed consent in simultaneous orders, any unit may enter a Pollutidarian vent on one turn and issue from any other open vent on the next. Pollutidarian orders to allow such moves should read "Allow (country) A (or F or C) Kxxx to enter vent" (where Xxxx is a province with an open vent), and "Allow A (or F or C) to exit vent Yyyy (where Yyyy is a province with an open vent). The first order must be written on the turn in which the unit enters the vent; the second on the turn the unit attempts to exit. Failure to submit the exit permission on the same turn as the attempted exit will result in annihilation of the surface unit. A surface unit may remain in Pollutidar for any length of time. A Pollutidarian unit may exit a vent while it is being used for entry by a surface unit, and vice -versa. Two Pollutidarian and two non-Pollutidarian units may also exchange places in this fashion; however, two units may not use the vent going the same direction.

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One more change: From the last line but one of Rule 5, delete from the parenthases the letters "PC". There are no Papal Cavalry units.

Map errors: Map 10 has 2 errors. A horizontal line separating Profinces 70 and 71 was omitted. It runs east to west so that Province 71 borders 69 and 70 does not border 68. Province Phoe (Phoenix) is #91, not 11, as indicated.

NEWS OF BEAUCOUILLON

BEAUCOUTLLON: King Cosimo XIII was hauled away from the roulette table by Prime Minister Count d'Avino long enough for him to sign the treaty which makes Beaucouillon a member of the Concert of Europe. "We are all in favor of the Concert of Europe," the King said. "I hope I get to sing bass," Count d'Avino, acting for the King, takes announced that Beaucouillon's seven cardinals would vote for Prince Rodrigo of Poderkagg in the election to vill the vacant Papacy. "Our delegation to the College of Cardinals," he said, "Will be led by the Primate of Beaucouillon, Pan Cardinal Satyrus.

MEWS OF THE CONFEDERATE STATES OF AMERICA

Lawton, Oklahoma (15 April 1501)(delayed): Negotiations between the Five Civilized Tribes and Confederate Commissioners have been crowned with success, provided the Confederate Congress and the Grand Council of the Tribes ratify the Treaty. It has been agreed that Oklahoma is to enter the Confederacy as a State with full rights, retaining existing tribal law except as to matters delegated to the Confederate Congress by the Constitution. Citizens of other States will have all the rights of born Cherokees within Oklahoma. The Five Tribes will adopt the Interstate Convention for the Return of Fugitive Slaves, as to fugitives entering the State after the effective date of the Treaty of Lawton only. Fugitives already in the new State will have 6 months to be accepted and entolled as tribesmen of one of the civilized tribes, otherwise to be returnable to their o ners, subject to the expenses of cature and meturn. Enrolled citizens of Oklahoma, members of the Fife Tribes, shall have full rights or citizenship in any of the other States notwithstanding that they may not be entirely of autochthonous ancestry. The compromise upon this point, which appears to have been brought about through the wisdom of Presiding Chief Quanah Parker, will bring an end to the principal outstanding cause of tension between th Five Nations and the Confederacy. Another point upon which agreement was arrived at only after lengthy discussion was that the public authority of the new State is to retain title to the vacant lands of the State, rather than vest the same in the Government of the Confederacy. It is thought that only the danger now threatening out of Apacheria and the lands of the Saints could have caused such great concessions.

LEESBURG (14 May 1501): The Congress of the Confederacy, in joint session, today heard Chief Commissioner John Davis urge acceptance of the Treaty of Lawton and overwhelmingly ratified the treaty by a vote of 147-2. Asked for the reason for his negative vote, Senator John Boredstiff of Jersey (a State very recently added to the Confederacy) would say only that Confederates should not degrade the Indians of Oklahoma by making citizens of them, and subjecting them to taxes. Instead, he said, they should be left free to carry on their usual pastimes of hunting and killing white men, stealing their servants and cattle, and of being fed through the winter by the whites. "Only in this wise," said the Senator, "can we properly recognize the Indian's imminent humanity. Relations with the Indians must remain under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs."

GUYMON, OKLAHOMA (23 June 1501): Members of the Oklahoma-Confederate Boundary surveying Commission, examining the western boundary of the new Confederate State, were fired upon today southwest of here by unknown riders. The survey commission is following the main channel of the Red River to the 100th parallel, this being the old Angle-Boucouillonese boundary line.

RICH MOND (5 April 1901): Delegates and Bishops to the Church of the Confederacy met in triemnial Council here in response to the summons of Archbishop L.K. Polk. They reclined the Archbishop's proposed donative to the Poor of the Northwest Territories, to be administered by Archbishop Jacob Goodbody of the Arctic, with overwhelming approval. The most moving occasion of the Council was the Address to the Chair in response to Archbishop Polk's announcement of his retirement as Primate of the Confederacy, delivered by the Very Reverend Fr. William Heard, long recognized as a rising star in Church affairs.

LEESBURG (10 June 1501): Undersecretary of State Bernard Baruch today declared that, while it is a great related to have worked out the means of bringing Oklahoma into the Confederacy, the situation on the entire Plains Frontier is one to cause a man "not to sleep a wink o'nights. Not only do our Quebecois allies feel endangered by the gestures of the Kalifites before their plains frontier, but a number of unusual smokes have been seen beyond Guymon, Oklahoma and by traders into Texas, and the tone of the discourse of the Eldest Brilliant at his most recent public appearance was distinctly disappointing." In related action, Lt. -General Kirby Smith and Rear Admiral Foxhall Parker have gone to Put-in Bay to meet with Marshal Folderol and the other Quebecois members of the Combined Chiefs of Staff for planning operations for the subjugation of the uncivilized tribes of the Western Plains. Major-General Ranald S. Mackenzie has departed the capital for Fort Worth, where he is expected to take over the newly created Southern Plains command.

YUCATAN (6 August 1501): Singing their famous Hymn, thousands of Confederate Marines under the command of Major-General William Walker swarmed ashore here today to quell the disorders and riots that have lately beset this tempest-tossed State.

### NEWS FROM COST AGUANA:

ALGIERS (1 September 1501): The Glorious Sultan Achmad VIII, who only a few months ago took control of Costaguana upon the death of his grandfather Stalachmite III, has begun far-reaching reforms aimed at, in the words of the Sultan, making Costaguana the most modern country in the Old World. Already vast sums are being poured into the educational system and the people have been given a voice in the selection of local leaders. The Universal Church and Islam, which were co-established, have been disestablished, much to the disgust of the antidisestablishmentarians, antimuslimidisestablishmentarians, and antiuniversidisestablish entarians. The minority most affected by this are the Arians and the Jews, both of whom fled to this country during persecutions of previous centuries. The Sultan will now be known as The Glorious President, in keeping with the modernization. Also, the Roman alphabet has been introduced for the writing of the local language, Karlish, which is a Romance language left over from the days when Costaguana was part of the Great Empire and which is unsuited to the Arabic script now used. The Arabic and Haussa speaking minorities will continue to use Arabic script. The official language of the Sultanate was heretofore Arabic, but this has been more true in theory than in practice. The Sultan advocates use of Karlish as a universal language, because of its (now) pheenetic spelling and Western-style grammar.

#### NEWS FROM EFGIART

CONGO: Samuel K. Ohmes announced that the RAIN line had been completed across the northern border of Efgiart. RAIN, Rapid Anti-Infiltration Network, was designed to prevent gun traders from Costaguana crossing the border into Efgiart. The Network system consists of three lines of cow bells strung on vines across the jungle. There was some speculation on how effective the Network would be since it was too dangerous to send patrols into the border country.

#### NEWS FROM ETHEROPIUM

ADDIS ABADA: Trashium Nott III flew in from Danakil to give his annual Opium Festival Address. His Majesty had some startling news: Etheropium has declared war on Squiji. This anti-Islam country has attacked an army of the Weed, leaving the King no alternative but to declare war on the worshippers of the god Jugu. This pagan country has been inclined for centuries to spit on Etheropium's religion. The Holy War which brough Etheropium freedom from the African chiefs is not recognized by the Chiefs of Squiji. The African Chiefs still believe Etheropium is theres because Rome gave it to

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them. Now, not honored, Etheropium has already scored major victories in the South.

KENYA: Ether is being used to put out all resistance from Squiji. The Armies of

the Meed are marching. Note that their extreme bravery is due to the effects of opium...

#### MEWS OF FRENCIANA

LUPLEENS (22 Movember 1501): The entire nation was plunged into mourning this morning following news of the death of Her Imperial Majesty Lurleen IX. Her Majesty was striken with a mysterious illness less than a week ago. Only 28 years old, She has borne the dual responsibility of caring for her two children, Philip and Christina, since the death of Her husband, the Duc de Angevin, two years ago, as well as that of leading the nation in the growing international crisis of the past year. Her Majesty will be remembered as a devoted mother and as a ruler who sought only peace and prosperity for Her people. It is expected that a regent will be named for Philip, who is only seven.

PHERIS (22 November 1501): In a news conference this afternoon, Her Majesty's personal physician, Dr. Henri d'Harve amounced that a special investigation had revealed that the Empress had died of a broken heart complicated by signs of peeri-peeri. The Empress has been in a dejected state of mind in recent months since reading the life of Her namesake, the first Lurleen, the tribulations She went through and Her own martyrdom.

PEERIS (24 November 1501): The Royal Council today appointed the Empress' former Prime Minister, Sir Richard the Lion-Hearted, Duc de Gadsden, and the Duc de Greene, Her Commander-in-Chief, to serve as co-regents for the Peeriphin Philip. Before the Periphin claque the two pledged to protect the Peeriphin from his enemies, domestic and foreign. Later in the day the Ducs met with representatives of Zelitch in an effort to provide Frenciana with a single united government during this crisis.

FERIS (25 November 1501): The Regency today declared a state of national emergency and announced it had definite information that a guerrilla war was being launched in southern Frenciana on behalf of Zelitch.

ST. PEERIGRAD (26 November 1501): In his first public press conference, King Zelitch (nicknamed the Long-Toed by the press) today declared himself to be the sole rightful ruler of Frenciana and announced that his armies were being ordered to the field to combat Frencianan Peerisite Forces (supporters of the Peeriphin).

PEERITER A BEEY (3 December 1501): Working alone in his cell here, Brother Martin continues to work on his exhaustive study of Peerism and Peeristism, which has already taken 42 years of his life and filled 153 volumes. At the moment Brother Martin is working on V. 154, entitled, "Peerism as it Relates to the Mystical Concepts of Ego and Id, or How to Stop Hating Yourself and Start Loving Peery."

## NEWS OF GLOCKORLA

PARHAN (18 July 1501): In solemn conclave, the eight bishops of Glockorla, and Sele, Archbishop of Parhan, met to determine their positions in the current election to fill the chair of St. Peter. Tolque, Bishop of Sydney, and Master of the Order of St. Gregory, was expected to propose unanimous support for Archbishop Peter of Nikolayevsk, high in the Councils of Miskatonia's Prime Minister, and one of the most energetic of the young Asian clergy. However, this met with little support. As Richard Collins, Bishop of Melbourne, put it: "What do we want with a Pope from the East, unless of course it be our own Sele? All it would mean is that the Imperial ambitions of that man's sponsor and its allies would be fire by the power of the Chair at Avalon. No, let us cast our votes for a European or perhaps an American. Besides, it does not look like a Pope will be selected and confirmed in his awful power until the end of next year -- most of the neutral Bishops, such as those of the Archipelago to the north, are abstaining to protest the War, which they see as a threat to their own petty power. Let us not create more problems in the troubled East. Let us vote for one who will confine his meddling to the other side of the world." Collins: words were apparently the concensus of ppinion in Parhan, for when the votes were counted, not even Tolque had voted for Peter. There were five votes for Rodrigo V of Venice, and four for Heard of Leesburg. It is rumored that the votes reflect the split between the Anglish and Parhani views of the role of the Cnurch in today's world. The Anglish, perhaps influenced by the incessant dynastic and colonial struggles in their native land, believe in a return to the ways of the Church

before the time of Sinistrius IV, while the Parhani see the Church as a means for righting the wrongs, both secular and sacred, of the world. Thus, the Parhani are rumored to have opted for Rodrigo, the dynamic, hard-driving Patriarch of Ravenna, over the choice of the Anglish, Father Heard of Leesburg, rumored to be an extremely pious, contemplative man. The split is reflected in the large numbers of Parhani clergy holding positions in the Government—Kona Ivorsen, brother of Koln Ivorsen, the young Consul of Forstellontir, is Defense Magis rate, and r mored as a replacement for Proconsul William Barrie when the latter steps down in January. It would not be the first time an Ivorsen held the office—Ceme Ivorsen was the second Viceroy (predecessor to the office of Proconsul under the Anglish King) of the original colony of New South Wales.

WELLINGTON (8 August 1501): The first ships of the Glockorlam fleet steamed into Wellington Harbor this morning at 6 a.m., only to find that George V had slipped out through the blockade, heading east. Admiral Ware ventured an opinion: "There have been rumors of Pollutidariam stirrings in Fiji, and perhaps George thought he could get a warm reception there. Even worse, perhaps it was the Pollutidariams who encouraged him in his folly, and now he flees to his masters."

## NEWS FROM GRAUSTARK

LEIFZIG (GNS) (1 May 1501): Citizen Joseph K., Chariman of the Council of PURGatory (all members of which use only initials to preserve democratic humility), today announced the goals of the PURG. "Eventually we must cover the world with Graffiti," he stated, "but we realize that our first task is to turn Graustark into a tabula rasa fit to receive the scribbles of history. Meanwhile, we must tolerate, con, and even seem friendly to the decadent governments of the rest of the world. Why, we even harbor no grudge against Poderkage for aiding the qondam Prince Ringletern in his treacherous flight from the country." At this point Chairman K. removed his pince-nez and smiled an inscrutible smile. "We cordially invite Citizen Ringletern to return. We will find a government job for him -- something to do with tending cabbages." In response to a question from a Beaucouillonian newsman, the Chairman stated that the burial place of the erstwhile royal family was being kept secret to avoid demonstrations by reactionary-royalists. "Let us turn to happier things", he said with a smile. "I am pleased to announce that 1501 will be a vintage year for Leipziger Sauerkraut." At the conclusion of the press conference, each newsman received a copy of a thin booklet entitled "Thoughts of Chairman K."

LEIPZIG UN ERGROUND (14 July 1501): A ffable, doddering old Adelbert, Graf von und zu Klammerausdruck and former Chancellor to His Teutonic Majesty, the late King Ermann, met secretly with foreign newsmen today. "Loyalists still exist in Graustark", he declared with bears in his rheumy eyes, "and we still persist despite the persecution of the evil Graffitists. Constantly we work the way for Crown Prince Ringlstern's return to pave, that he his rightful throne may mount. Long live the house of Wolfgepufft-Strohdach." In closing, the Graf warned against drinking 1501 Leipziger Sauerkraut. "Alas," he wept, "it shouldbe as a holy relic stored away." The Graf also denied the rumor that the Princess Ermentrude had survived the Dekrautization and was living as a fishwife in Bremerhaven.

#### NEWS FROM HYDUNDERBAD

HYDUNDERBAD: The Hindunderbadi Press will sell or rent newspaper space to any loud-mouthed nation which can't subsist on its own one-page allowance in the international newspaper, Oz Free Press. Supplies, war materials, cities, and gold will be accepted as negotiable tender. Sell a few of your people and gain a greater voice in the world!

NORTHERN HYDUNDERBAD: The Annual Himalayan Visit of many of the world's celebrities is on. This custom, which began nearly 10 years ago, has since taken the proportions of a major social event. Actors, acknesses, millionaires, on camels, horses, donkeys, even in balloons, are traveling to the hundreds of sacred meditation inns to learn the true meaning of life. The meditation inn itself was an idea pioneered by His Holiness, the monk Maharishi Dollah, who offered accommodations to visiting pilgrims in the Mountainview Spa, a 60-room meditation inn which has since accommodated such people as the deposed King Lyndum, the members of the Liverpool Orchestra, and the famous Eric Blake (alias J. Edgar Hoover). In July 1500 the Maharishi moved to the Hawaiian Islands, where he

#### NEWS OF QUEBEC

MONTREAL (1 August 1501): Parlament and the peoples of Quebec are in an uproar over Efgiart's admission that they possess Automatic Rocket Interception Deterrent (ARID).

When planshal Folderol was questioned about rockets, he angrily replied, "The Grand Army of the Republic of Quebec is equipped with the finest array of munitionment that technology and money can provide. If the Grand Army is not equipped with rockets, it is because they are of no military value." Professor Ivy Walls, renowned scholar and inventor, was interviewed on the QBC about the history of rocket development and use. He noted that in the third century, Grand Coolie XIV, Warlord of the Yellow Feril, used crude reckets in his conquest of the Suey Kingdom (Xamadu is the surviving remmant of the Empire of the Yellow Peril which, in the 5th Century embraced all the lands from the Black Sea and the Baltic to the Pacific Ocean and from the Arctic to the Indian Ocean. The Suey Kingdom, often referred to as the "Chop Suey Kingdom" because the Chop were its only dynasty, disappeared from history with Coolie XIV's conquest. The Chop ruled the area of Asia now comprising Lompoc). This is the only known instance in which rockets were used.

MONTREAL (11 August 1501): The Ministry of Defense has authorized an expenditure of 5,000,000 pounds to investigate the possibility of developing rockets. M. Alexandre Hamilton insists that every effort would be made to discovere if a missile gap exists.

QUEBEC (18 August 1501): Dr. Sputnik, of the Institute of Astrology and Advanced Aphorisms, read a paper before BAD arguing that the first country to develop powerful rockets would rule the Earth. He stated devices which would circle the Earth at high altitudes can be constructed. Such devices would carry many large missiles. By simply launching thousands of such missiles, each transporting a huge warhead of powerful explosives, their owner would devastate the population and industrial centers of his enemies. BOOM-BOOM, RIGOLET (9 December 1501): It appears that Quebec has put the first man into space. Yesterday at 12 noon, the first manned vehicle for space flight was launched. Moon I, under the command of Col. Harry Paws, famous big-game hunter and first pilot for Commodore Frost-bite's Arctic Expedition, is thought to be circling the Earth at an altitude of 100 miles. When Dr. Sputnik was questioned about the success of the launch, he said, "when this little red button was pushed, KA-BOOM!, they were gone. A search of the launch pad and the immediate area was made, but no trace of Moon I and her 3-man crew was found. I can only surmise that Col. Harry Paws and his brave crew are in orbit."

#### NEWS OF PODERKAGG

GASTRITIS (15 September 1501): The bells of the capital of the Celestial Kingdom rang in ecstasy today to celebrate the wedding of His Highness Prince Ringlstern von Wolfgepuift-Strohdach and Her Highness Princess Amemia Sodom-Borgia. His Highness, Heir Expectant to the Throne of Graustark, is expected to beseech his cousin-in-law, King Pandemonium V, to lead a military expedition against the Graffitists and help restore his Crown. His Celestial Majesty, who is currently making the rounds of every brothel in Gastritis, Novi Sodom, Sofiya, and Athens which serves peeled and seeded grapes, is expected to refuse.

LENG (DWE): As I write this plea, warning, whatever my fellow rulers may call it, night is falling in Leng. Indeed, it is hardly anything but dusk here, or so it seems. On this evening I also feel that the sun is setting at last on my tragic family, the Saran-Koenish. For some weeks this city has been nearly empty, its soldiers gone, to Graustark, perhaps, or Sevastopol, or Siunik, or Miskatonia. Why can say? # AN ABBREVIATED HISTORY OF THE WEST by Dave Lebling

The present Romanic Dynasty may be the oldest (in Europe), if the change in dynasty of 950 was the last; this when the dynasty of Liutprand was overthrown by Pepin I, father of Pepin II the Great, and grandfather of Charlemagne. Charlemagne, struggling, without too much success, against his half-brother Carloman, lost the seat of the Empire, but precipitated the division of Western Europe between the west (the Goths and Germans) and the East (the Huns and Lombards). Carloman became Emperor, but the damage was done. Charlemagne, "bought off" by the Consulship in what was left of the West (Bralla II having recognized the Barbarians in the West), proceeded to establish a power base.

The wars of Charlemagne against Hispania and Frenca are too many to be chronicled, but when he was done there was a reasonably sized empire in Frenca and Hispania ruled by him. His son Louis, however, was not so ambitious, and was content to maintain the Empire as it was. He passed it to his sons, Charles II and Lothar, who proceeded to have a civil war. Lothar, who was favored by the Romans (due to his being a son of Heguilda, an Attilid; the Attilid Party being strong in the West), won, and Charles went into exile in Frenca (perhaps founding the dynasty of which Lurleen IX was the scioness).

In any event, the situation in Western Europe was confused at best. Rome, in spite of having renounced its claims to the area, was active, and often an Emperor (Carhoman's descendents felt themselves to be Western at heart) would try to reconquer it. The Kingdoms of Frenca, Anglanda, Aquitana, and Novarra were always at war among themselves and with the Empire. Also there were the Markovinians, Saxons, Graubeins, and even at times the Magyars, looting and pillaging. Eventually, Frenca and Anglanda asserted their supremacy (Declaration of Londinium) and backed it up during the War of the Declaration. This was better their falling out over the New World, as it had not yet been discovered. This situation lasted for centuries, with the West in uneasy peace with Rome, acting as a buffer against the barbarians (Frenca then extended well into what is now Graustark).

When Hardo I arrived on the scene, Germania was a welter of feudal confusion, full of barbarians who had been shunted north by the vigor of the Attilids and, later, the Pepinids. It was his military and political genius which enabled the tribes of Germany to unite. He drove the Frencans from Germania, extending his sway east and south. He was crowned King of Graustark after the Imperial Cession of 563, when his de facto rule

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was made de jure by Otto IV, a weak Emperor. Hardo's sons were as brilliant as he; his son Gundo reigned from 591 to about 660. Hardo II, Gundo's son, is credited in Graustarkian legent as having caused Gerbert III to move the Imperial capital to Antioch. Historians discount this, but Hardo II did sack Venetia in 686, and the capital was moved in 688.

The end of the Protectorate of the West was foredoomed from its founding. When the Mongols under Genghis Khan appeared (c775) and swept all before them, the West united for a time. However, like all barbarians before them, the Mongols conquered, settled, and were assimilated. In fact, they conquered very little after Genghis' death at Cracow in 794. Some of the provinces between Ruritania and Graustark have large numbers of criental people, but Genghis' death sealed the doom of the Mongols in the west, although there was to be a glorious flowering in the east later (the Yellow Peril). Part of the plan for resistance to the Khan was the Protectorate of the West, drawn up at Avignon by the rulers of Frenca, Anglanda, and Rome (779). Graustark joined later. Basically, the conduct of government was ceded to Rome, which was beginning her military renaissance with the conquest of Africa. It is possible the Protectorate might have been established even without the Mongol invasion, as the Kings of the West were afraid of the rising Roman power, but unsure how to combat it. The only solution was capitulation. Already, Roman legions under Saladin were ready to strike at Gaul.

The Protectorate lasted less than 200 years. The Mongols were assimilated, and Roman preoccupation with the East sealed its doom. In 950, after 14 years of war, the victorious West eliminated the last Roman garrison (at Nice) and declared the end, not only of the Protectorate, but of Rome itself. They were about 200 years premature, but as far as the West was concerned, they were right. Romany never again held power west of Greece in Europe.

# A SHORT HISTORY OF QUEBEC TO 1435 by John Smythe

The first permanent colony in North America was founded by settlers from the area of Normandy now known as Peerst. Led by the adventurer Henri Forager, 112 families landed near what is now Quebec City on 4 June 1199. The influential, the wealthy, and the powerful of Frenca were not among the early settlers. The oppressed, the downtrodden, the conquered, and the second sons sought a new life in the virgin wilderness. Most of the bigotry of the old country was discarded, and no landed aristocracy developed (due to the almost endless supply of fertile land). Nor did a commercial aristocracy, as a debtor had only to flee into the wilderness to escape the mionions of the creditor. Not even the oppressive rule of the Frencan Kings enabled the institutions of feudalism to flourish.

The colony survived the first years through a close friendship with the Algonkin Nation. Intermarriage became common (and still is). In fact, the first female borm in the colony was the daughter of fichele Lunout and her husband Oldwolf. By the 1330s, New Frenca (or "Quebec" as the new worlders preferred to call their country) included most of what is now the Provinces of Cabotia, Quebec, Montrel, and Ottawa. The population, including the Algonkin Nation and allied tribes which enjoyed full citizen ship, was 5,000,000.

In 1331, the Frencan Kings decided to exercise complete authority. The young parliament was dissolved. From 1331 to 1395 the King's Governor, supported by the King's Regulars and Mercenaries, exercised the King's authority. Several attempts were made to restore freedom of life, liberty, and estate: in 1345 the Algonkin Nation and the freeholders fought for 9 months to eliminate slavery; in 1387 the Montcalm and the L'Ourverture families led a fruitless struggle to restore parliament and eliminate confiscation of property without due process; and in 1387 the whole colony rose against the infamous Duke Charles de Gaulblader. But the Regulars and the Mercenaries were very efficient fighters, and the rebellions were crushed. Quebec became the provider of the primary commodities demanded by Frenca's industry and growing population. This exploitation enabled Frenca to gain a position of paramountcy among the welter of petty states in the West.

The Battle of Verdun is considered to be the single most important battle in Quebec's long struggle for independence, and no Quebecan participated! When Frenca attacked Anglanda because of her support of the German Coalition, the Peerists expected an easy victory.

With her seasoned troops and an unparalleled record of military achievements, Peerist Frenca was the most powerful nation in Europe. Who had ever heard, then, of the brilliant Earl of Edinburg? On 15 August 1395, near the small village of Verdun, Anglanda and her German allies annihilated the Frencan host. (N.B.: See Conrad's excellent description of the three days in his book, The Darkest Hour.) To ward off total defeat, the Peerists called home their Regulars and their Mercenaries. Only a small force of sympathizers remained to maintain control. (N.B.: Most historians assume that the Peerists believed the rebel leadership had been destroyed by the reprisals after the Gaulblader Rebellion. Actually, the infrastructure of the resistance was not affected by the arrests and executions of 192.) Two months later, the rebel army defeated the King's men at Montreal. Four months later, the provinces were controlled by the rebels.

To ensure a continued supply of foodstuffs and raw materials for the war, the Peerists were forced to treat with the newly formed Parliament. Though the Peerists retained the right to control Quebec's foreign affairs, Parliament controlled internal affairs. The long and destructive war, which was waged intermittently 1395-1435, and during which most of Anglanda fell to the Peerist armies, so weakened Frenca that she was unable to reassert her authority. Besides, over 250,000 Quebecans served in the Frencam armies. Several became respected King's Captains. As a result, Quebec's army was as well-trained and as well-lead as any that then existed. In 1435 the Peerists recognized Quebec's right to complete self-determination.

A SHORT HISTORY OF THE FEDERAL CONFUSIONATE OF LOMPOC AND COYOTE WELLS

Volume One: From the Creation to the Mild Revision

Lompoc's early history is sketchy, but one fact which is still preserved in writing is that the creation took place on 17 March 3,699,451,700,005 PT (Past Time, meaning anything except tomorrow and points beyond). This date is proved by a small slip of treebark, once thought lost, but now rediscovered and reposing in the Luang Praband National Museum and Shoe Repair Shop. Carefully written across the face of this strip of bark are the words: "EARTH. CREATED TODAY. I CERTIFY UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY THAT THIS SIGNATURE APPEIDED HERETO IS MY OWN TRUE SIGNATURE AND IS DULY WITNESSED AND APPROVED. Done this 17th day of March, 3,699,451,700,005. (signed) GOD. (Witness signatures) Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Christ (this latter signature in one hand only, below which are the initials, in a different hand) MC. The reverse side of this document is marked: POST CARD -- THIS SIDE FOR ADDRESS ONLY, and bears a picture of a strange and futuristic edifice with a partially intelligible legend, WELCOME TO LAS VEGAS (sic -- the last two words are unknown to scholars, though Melvin Myron Myslivicek of the Luang Prabang Conservatory has suggested a typo for LOST AGES -- this seems barely possible). There is a photostat of this document in Manila, and another in Berlin. Academic opinion of the authenticity of this valuable item is unanimously in favor of it. The last serious attempt to discredit the so-called "Bark Theory of Evolution" was 16 years ago, when three professors from the University of Teheran issued a short book entitled, "Why the Bark Theory Cannot Be Correct Because on 17 March 3,699,451,699,989 (this is the date on the actual pamphlet), There Was a Heavy Overcast in Lompoc Which Would Have Limited Visibility Beyond the Point of Reasonable Doubt". It was widely circulated for some months, but was totally discredited when one of the authors admitted that his evidence was different from that in his booklet. His real facts, he stated, were that he knew God and had been told that the Bark Document was a somewhat obscene party joke played on God's mother-in-law.

The Creation having been established with certainty, scholars now estimate that the process of evolution extended to 7,446,912 PT. In this year man was created, by a somewhat obscure process of osmosis and Wilhold Glue. The first man's first words were, "Where's the f\*\*\*ming Broads?" (a tape recording of this statement, narrated by Edward R. Murrow, exists). The first man, dam N. Eave, was apparently also the first Pope, though modern Church officials tend to disparage this revelation. His wife, contrary to popular legend, was actually named Hortense, Confusion stems from calling her Mrs. Eave. Much of the land is jungle, and the finest jewelery and carvings with, after the passage of a handful of centuries, be just so much peat moss. It is a major mystery that the Sacred Bark, described supra, has managed to escape the ravages of time. A few other relics have also miraculously escaped, but they are scaree and difficult to assess. This history of Lompoc proper begins with the founding of the first Lompoquienne Empire, set at the arbitrary date of 44,673 PT. The reasons for that date are numerous and a bit confused; suffice it to say that the span 44,685-44,670 is sufficient to include the founding of the Empire with absolute certainty. The customary date, however, holds much credence in popular legend in Lompoc; every year numbered "73" is cause for national holidays three times a week.

We have now traced the significant happenings in prehistoric Lompoc. The next volume will deal with the Barbarian Invasions of 44,940-44,673 PT, immediately prior to the foundation of the First Empire; we shall also see where the name Lompoc comes from, how the Empire was established, how the first Emperor managed to survive 62 known assassination attempts by building a trap-door from the bedroom into the cesspool. Finally, we will examine one of Lompoc's most astounding historical records; an hadroglyphic diary of the reign of the first half-dozen Emperors, written in their own respective hands on the walls of the aforementioned cesspool in an unusually well-preserved inking material. Add thereto: "No unit convoyed by Vulcanian ships may be landed on any home supply center (save one belonging to the power being convoyed, whether owned by him or not), nor within a distance of one province of any such center, nor on any other supply center, except one not currently owned or owned by a nation in civil disobedience. Vulcan may transport no more than two units of the same country in any given year.

5. Replacements and stand-bys. The limited issue of TOFP has created a problem. So has the probability that this game may, literally, last forever. Therefore, I have cancelled this 'zine's subscription policy. Instead, I would like to create a self-imiting membership for the game, including stand-by players, who would pay the regular fee. Assuming enough of these, the fee would drop to \$1 per 4 or even 5 issues. Therefore, insert the following Rule: "23. The number of stand-by players in the game will be limited by the ability of the Gamesmaster to supply them with the requisite materials (maps, rules, current back issues, &c.). Any active player may propose a person for stand-by status in the game. Upon an affirmative vote of a majority of players casting an affirmative or negative vote, the person nominated will be accorded stand-by status at the game-fee then pertaining. Only a designated stand-by may succeed to an active position in a game, in order of seniority, upon the resignation, default by failure to submit three consecutive moves, death, or disappearance of an active player.
No person may subscribe to The Oz Eree Press save by virtue of obtaining stand-by status."

This rule goes into effect with issue #6; in the interim I will assign a few standby players to start things off and inform subscriber applications of the necessity of obtaining stand-by status. After that, it will be up to you-all.

By the way, when you nominate stand-by players, please try to keep in mind the purpose and intent of this game, which is to have a good time in a feeble-minded sort of way, mainly with the propoganda. New, inexperienced players in the Diplomacy field, or non-players generally, probably would not fit in. Good players and good press-release writers are what we mostly need, for compatability with the present group. Be very selective, as my supply of things is very limited.
- 9. The Rules. Just to anticipate the request, eventually I will be putting out a complete set of rules to take into account all the changes, additions, and interpretations given out ex cathedra thus far. Thereafter, supplement sheets will probably be the order of the day until a new edition of the rules is called for.
- 10. Money: A levy of \$1, to cover issues 4, 5, 6, and 7 (5 will be short) is due now. Many of you have extra cash on hand here, and will not owe anything. If you are in doubt, please ask. I will endeavor to send an individual financial statement to each of you with issue #5. As this issue is not over 20 pages, no one will be charged for excess material.
