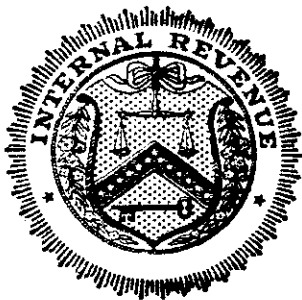
BERLIN PRESS- The English are coming, the English are coming!!!!
