1. This issue will be terribly late. Today is in fact the 6th of Sept, but I hope to have this issue completed by today or tomorrow. Liz and I were on a small vacation in Connecticut from 1-5 Sept and only returned home last night. It took me over a half hour just to read the mail that had built up. Of necessity, this issue will be a short one. Contrary to what might be written inside, most of the press has been deleted so that we can get this issue out. Sorry 'bout that, folks..

2. Does anyone know the correct address of Sgt Zack Richardson? I have had the last two PLEs returned from the Philipines, and do not intend to waste anymore stamps until this shit ceases.

3. There are many announcements that I will no doubt forget thisish, hopefully anything I've forgotten that I was supposed to mention will be noted by you people.

4. In 1972EA I have been razed over the coals by a player for an error I made, and I can see no constructive purpose in the manner in which it is done. It so happens, Mr. Hollingsworth, that I did not send out notification of two GM errors in your game as I usually do. The issue that those mistakes happened was #10, in which there was a total of some six mistakes in 4 or 5 games. All the notifications of GM error were sent out, except 72EA, for which I'm sorry, but it's a bit late to go back and play over the whole game to your satisfaction. For what its worth, I'd like to tell the world that I think its a cheap shot when you try to blame a GM error for a deteriorating position, or for the fact that the game is no longer moving along the lines you've set out for it. In any event, "press releases" such as submitted by Mr. Hollingsworth this turn will never be printed unless they are toned down. Feel free to write and accuse me of censorship now, D.H.

5. ALL PLAYERS NOTE: you should have received, or be receiving within a few days of this, a copy of the new house rules. READ THEM.....

6. Are you a GM about to start up a YV game? I'll sell you 15 sets of a YV map for \$2, so you don't even bother to have to print them. (Single YV maps are still up for grabs at 24¢ /in stamps/ a copy. Copies of the HYBOREAN AGE II map are 16¢ a copy.

7. Of the four games opened last issue, three are filled (and started), which was a bit faster than even I expected. Game #9 (regular) is begun within, as is Game #8 (Hyborean Age II). Game #10 (regular, carbon copy) has begun by itself outside the pages of PELLUCIDAR, altho it is considered part of PELLUCIDAR. Game #11 (regular, carbon copy) still has openings.

8. We have also picked up an orphan game, the MARCUS YV game. I need standbys for this game, and one player has dropped out already.

It was the AUSTRIAN player who dropped out, I believe, and he has a position of some 6 or 7 units, at least. Interested? Please contact me as soon as possible.

9. Some of you may have noticed that PELLUCIDAR now goes out to 101 people. This circulation figure is real, and does not include people who have dropped out etc. Under that method, used by some publishers, PELLUCIDAR would have stats of over 130, which would not only be untrue, but which would be expensive to me besides. Only two people receive complimentary copies of PELLUCIDAR. They are John Moot and Tom Eller (whoops, and Don Lowry), a total of three. I am of the opinion that PELLUCIDAR has the least amount of trades (20) of a major zine (being one with a circulation of over 100). An interesting comparison, for example, is COSTAGUANA, in my opinion the best zine there is (at least, my personal favorite). It has a rather large circulation of over 130, I think, but close inspection reveals that it has over 60 trades! Which means I've got more subscribers, and about the average amount of players. Then there is HOOSIER ARCHIVES, with only 7 players, but 5 billion trades and 10 billion subbers. Well, almost. Interesting, hey what?

10. A good time was had at the DEWCON. I played one game each of QUEBEC, 1812, and Age of Sail miniatures. The greatest thrill was the 9mm Napoleonic miniatures, with yours truly and Pete Rice as the froggies. Ah, what blood and glory there was in that battle! A lot of fun, I'll tell you. I'm starting my own 9mm Frenchies very soon.

11. PELLUCIDAR was invaded a few weeks ago by Steve Hall, one of the players within these pages. It was fun meeting Steve, and we played one game of STALINGRAD and two games of BORODINO while he was here. Hope to get together again real soon.

12. THE MIDWESTERN COURIER is scheduled to invade here within a few weeks. It will be good to see Ray and Peggy Sowers again, and no doubt by now they have brushed up on their RISK game, so I'll have to think of something else to play. Of course, as any male ego-tripper knows, Peggy and Liz have very little influence on whatever games we do play, the outcome of said games being decided by the battle between the two super-intellec[t]s of the group, Ray and myself, of course. (Hoooooooooeeeeeeee. Is he gonna get it now!)

13. Are you passing through Maine? Want to visit the Wolfslair? Just give us a little advance notice, and you can stay here at least a few days, and we'll have go at a few games while you're here. Crowds of up to two can be handled in comfort, more if you've got a sleeping bag with ya. But we must know when you're coming!
