PARIS-- The Prime Minister today announced that the French First Army was ordered into Belgium to restore anarchy to some degree of law and order. The PM also announced that the second Army was ordered to capture Spain. He said that this, in addition to the seizure of Portugal by the First Fleet, is expected to meet little opposition.

PARIS-- The President of the French Republic hopes that one of Germany's friendly neighbors is France. War, especially with Germany, is not what the French people want.

DELHI (UDP)- Before a joint session of Congress today, the Indian First Minister, Jahan Stavanas, formally announced the annexation of Burma to the Federation of India. A partial text of the statement is as follows: "Ever since the expulsion, a generation ago, of the European colonialist nations-France, England, Portugal, and Holland from the Indian sub-continent by a national army, led by our present glorious Emperor, Rajni Singh I, then warrior-ruler of the Sikh kingdom, our national policy, whichever political party has been in power, has been to oppose any renewal of European colonialist ambitions. Due to recently uncovered efforts by the British Govt to gain control of Burma by means of a total trade monopoly, we are annexing that country to the Federation, with all the rights and privileges of a member state. Furthur, we warn the French, but especially the English, neo-imperialists, that any more attempts at expansion in SE Asia will also be resisted by the Indian nation, if necessary, by force of arms." The declaration went on to call for anti-colonialist solidarity among the three great Asian powers. The leader of the opposition Buffalo party, Lalam Faradark, could not be reached for comment on the speech, but the Prince Regent, Iskander, speaking for his father, came out in favor of the policy of the First Minister and his Majority Tiger party. This imperial endorsement guaranteed no veto of the large, new military appropriations bill already on the Emperor's desk, laying the foundations for a potential doubling of Indian active military strength.

BERLIN- Germany is distressed as to the ominous French silence.... Germany calls on her Italian friends to the south and her English allies to the north to find out the reason for this silence. There must be a reason....writers cramp? laringitis, athlete's foot?

TRIESTE- Emperor James Hapsburg of Austria wishes to assure their Honors Czar Douglas and King Chic of Italy officially, that the Spring "raids are the results of jumpy border commanders reacting to scandalous war-rumors and in no way refelct the desires of the Emperor. The amity of his two sister states Italy and Russia being demonstrated

by their respective Spring moves, the armies and fleets will be called back in the fall; the border commanders duly disciplined. This information has also, of course, been transmitted to the Italian and Russian Foreign Ministries through the normal Diplomatic channels. His Majesty is confident that these brash actions will not cause permanent or irreparable harm to the Italian-Austro-Russian Concord, and respectfully reminds his friend the Czar that Galacia is a province of the Austro-Hungarian Empire. BARAD FOREST- a fact the Russian player appears to be well aware of, unlike your inability to see Rumania is and always will be a Russian sphere of influence. Tch-tch. Onward Orthodox soldiers!
