Last issue I attempted to give a plug to Bill Dutcher and the JASOOMIAN, I think I did a fairly good job, even if I did leave out all of Bill's address. Sigh. Now let's get into ques. 1-6. I'll give the bulk responses first, and then give individual answers as they pop up.

Q. #1 dealt with schedule A or schedule B. The score was 16A to 9B. PELLUCIDAR shall begin using plan A as of now. Comments:  
 "Games go to slowly, plan A would aid considerably....I prefer to leave things the way they are.....A puts more uncertainty into the game, thus making it more like real-life diplomacy... I prefer the old system.....I don't favor either one.....Now that I've figured it out, I prefer the present system.....The game is too slow already, prefer A....B wastes time.....Want a quicker game, plan A....B too long, and, perhaps, boring..... We should have three week deadlines...."((So, plan A it is.))

QUESTIONNAIRE RESULTS, CONT...

Q. #2 dealt with starting a game other than Diplomacy. 15 people want to play in various games, so I've got a problem here. IF I do start one, it appears that USN and BLITZKRIEG are the two most likely candidates. I've still got to evaluate how much work it would be to run one of these things. More later.

Q. #3 dealt with the Super-Game. 6 persons answering the Ques. would like to play, and one other who didn't do the Ques. It appears this game will start after all, this fall, of course. A couple people in the hobby have assigned the ridiculous fee of \$10 for a regular game. Therefore, the fee for the SG will be 10.10, and I'll shoot that higher if I see others charging more for just REGULAR games, \$10 for a regular game. Outasite! If you're dumb enough, and rich enough, to pay it, more power to ya.

Q. #4 dealt with persons interested in beginning in regular Diplomacy openings. I've got a problem here too, with 14 people expressing their intent to sign up in PELLUCIDAR again. HMMMMMM.

Q. #5 asked if PELLUCIDAR was good enough to substitute for a Sears catalog in the outhouse. 23 people thought it was. 2 communist, fascist, liberal swine said bad things about it. Heh-heh, they were gassed. Some of the comments:

((These Ques. are fun at times, I enjoyed this.))

Q. #6 asked for suggestions to improve the zine. Comments by you folks: "Articles on the Game!.....Use more articles..... more editorial stuff-use abbr. to save space.....Censor the press.....shorten your houserules ((I plan to, eventually)).. PELLUCIDAR would be more enjoyable if you were a lot less cute and a shade less arrogant ((but then would it be fun?))..... You ought to write more.....Keep it as is.....((That's all)).

From the above, I have decided the following will happen: This fall, I will open up the SG and two regular games, perhaps three if Tom Eller wants to do another. We will probably have to go to abbreviations...the game other than Dippy is still hanging in the air...fees will be \$5/\$6, depending on who you are.

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The following is an excerpt from JASTRZAB #16, which concerns the origins of the YV game. Stan Wrobel should know....he lives in Youngstown!

A SHORT HISTORY OF THE YOUNGSTOWN VARIANT, by Stan Wrobel.

The original Youngstown Variant was designed here (as the name indicates) by one Jack Yucker who never played postal Diplomacy. Long since then forgotten, it has not been played in person or ever mentioned. As the original version did not have the OBB boxes (which were added by Rod Walker), travel around the world was impossible. Hence the games played here either stalmated in the middle of Russia, in an East-West confrontation, or the new powers triumphed. Only about three or four face-to-face games were contested here before the game dropped out of favor. Some have asked why the Americas were not included to make the game truly world-wide. One of the obscure reasons that I was able to dig out of Koning was the fact that Tucker (who always operated on a grand scale) made the original map as large as a full-size bed with the accompanying problems of storage and transportation. Must have been before King-size beds came into vogue...or water beds...

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So there you have it-another bit of info gleaned on the YV. The man who designed it never played postal Diplomacy! Interesting, to say the least.
