I recently acquired a series of letters concerning this subject which were carelessly left in a pair of Levi-Strauss of Perry Leeri during a game of strip hearts. Naturally,I was the big winner and this section will be used to inform you of the new knowledge I have acquired.(concerning the correspondence).

Of course most of you are familiar with the life and loves of Pilsudski and Paderewski but for those of you that have led sheltered lives, I will introduce you to the subject. T

These letters were written between 1918 and 1934 concerning Pilsudski and Paderewski,two dynamic leaders of Poland from 1919 to the Mid 30's. These letter are of several types: direct letters between Joe Pilsudski and Iggy Paderewski, letters between the two mens secretaries containing messages from Joe to Iggy and visa versa to visa versa, and letters between the two secretaries that served them throughout the period who were close friends and almost alter egos.Joe's secretary was Marc

Sawchuck and Iggy's was Wilhelm Rebye. The friendship between the two secretaries was much more intense than that of the rulers and their informal comments tend to clarify the formal letters of Joe and Iggy.

The history of Poland during this era of turbulence has much to teach us and especially the relations between Russia and Germany during this period will offer us much food for thought on the politics of Eastern Europe.

Even more interesting are the contrasting personalities of these two men that were so devoted to Poland.

This section is a different section compared to other non-Polish zines but I hope you will find it interesting, informative and at times humorous.

Next issue will contain the first letter concerning the crisis in establishing the first Polish government and Poland's role in the Versailles peace conference.
