Underlined moves do not succeed. The Austrian Army Serbia and the French Army Portugal are both annihilated for lack of open retreats (the Austrian Army Serbia cannot retreat to Albania since that province is left open due to a standoff). The English Fleet Sweden may retreat to Finland, the Gulf of Bothnia, the Baltic, or off the board. The German Fleet North Sea may retreat to either the Norwegian Sea, the Skaggerak, Denmark, the Helgoland Bight, Belgium, the English Channel, Yorkshire, or off the board. These retreats should be submitted along with the "Fall 1903" orders, which may be made conditional upon them. Should any player object to the request for conditional moves (because of the large number of retreats open to the German Fleet) the "Fall 1903" moves will be delayed two weeks, and only the retreats will be published next time.

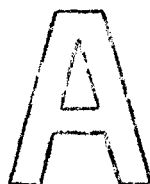
