T: (4) ven, rom, nap, tun. No change.

H: (6) mos, sev, rum, bud, vie, sve. No change.

F: (7) con, ank, smy, gre, ser, bul, kri. No change, build one if f lon /r/ oth.

vie, swe. Build three (was one short) and will remain short if anything
/r/ oth.

a little while.

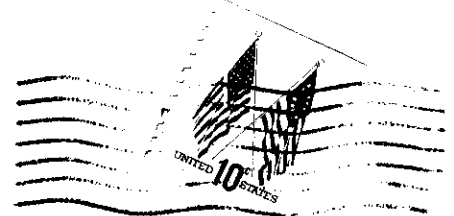
Harry figured that the strike won't affect him too much. If so, good;
