II. Scrapping of naval vessels

A. A ship is scrapped (dismantled) at the rate of 2,000

tons per month. Once started the process is irreversible.

B. Out of the 2,000 tons scrapped you receive 1,000 tons (1/2) which can be used for new ships etc.

C. In addition to the points received all the guns and FI the ship originally mounted are made available in proportion to the amount of the ship that is scrapped.

EXAMPLE: KOFU 6,700 tons, 9-5.9", 4-88mm, 6 FI,

as a result of scrapping her you would receive 3,365 pts.

It will take 3,365 months (about 11 weeks) (or 100 days)

so you would receive a gun 5.9" every 11 days, 88mm every 25 days and a FI every 16 days.

It takes ten U.S. to carry one economic point up to five provinces.

For every province over five add one U.S. Rumania is 10 areas off the S.W. edge of the playing board. An U.S. can make only one trip per month. There will be no overland trade even between adjoining countries. Example: Japan (Kobe) to British (portsmouth). Distance five areas. Japan uses twenty U.S., British thirty U.S. In return for her two points Japan receives 2.4 points British receives for her 3 points she sold to Japan 2.4 points (a loss of .6 points). The seller thus does not lose any money but the buyer (she sent the ship) in British lost out. Needless to say the U.S. are subject to sinking
