Introducing:

DIPLOMACY 'ZINES IN PRINT

Have you ever tried to find a good 'zine to play in? Didn't you wish for a list of them that included a description of what was to be found in each one so that you could make an informed choice as to where to place your dollar? Wouldn't you want that list to be current, with the newest 'zines included, and those that had gone out of print recently culled? DIP ZIP has been created just to meet these needs.

DIP ZIP will be a thrice-yearly voluntary listing by pubbers that not only includes the bare facts about each listing 'zine, but also includes a description of that 'zine written by the pubber himself. No longer will there be a complaint that a reviewer either does not understand the 'zine, or through bias unrelated to the 'zine, misrepresents it to potential readers. Also, being put out thrice-yearly, new 'zines can be included and out of print 'zines culled faster in DIP ZIP.

DIPLOMACY 'ZINES IN PRINT will include any and all submissions made by 'zines and hobby services. Save for a single cover page explaining what DIP ZIP is, the listing will be totally in the words of each individual lister. There will be NO editorializing, either in the listing itself or in the cover letter. DIP ZIP will be made available to anybody providing a large SASE, save for the listing pubbers, who will each receive a copy free. Contributions to help defray costs will be gratefully accepted, but will not be required, either to be listed or to receive DIP ZIP.

A DIP ZIP listing will consist of\*

- 1) 'Zine Name
- 2) Pubber's name and address
- 3) Sub fees
- 4) Game fees
- 5) publication interval/deadline interval
- 6) A short (ten typed lines max) exposition paragraph written by the pubber explaining his 'zine.

Exposition paragraphs WILL NOT be edited. They will be chopped off at the end of ten typed lines if longer than that. Listing pubbers are reminded that prospective subbers will be making decisions on which magazine to sub to based upon these paragraphs, so a modicum of restraint in language used is suggested.

I am looking forward to a first publication date of 9/1/85, with future updated listing following every four months thereafter. A month previous to each future update, I will send a reminder to each listed pubber, so that they may change their current listing if they wish. Each listed pubber, though, will have to indicate that they wish to continue to list in DIP ZIP. Otherwise I will assume that they have gone out of print and their listing will be culled.
